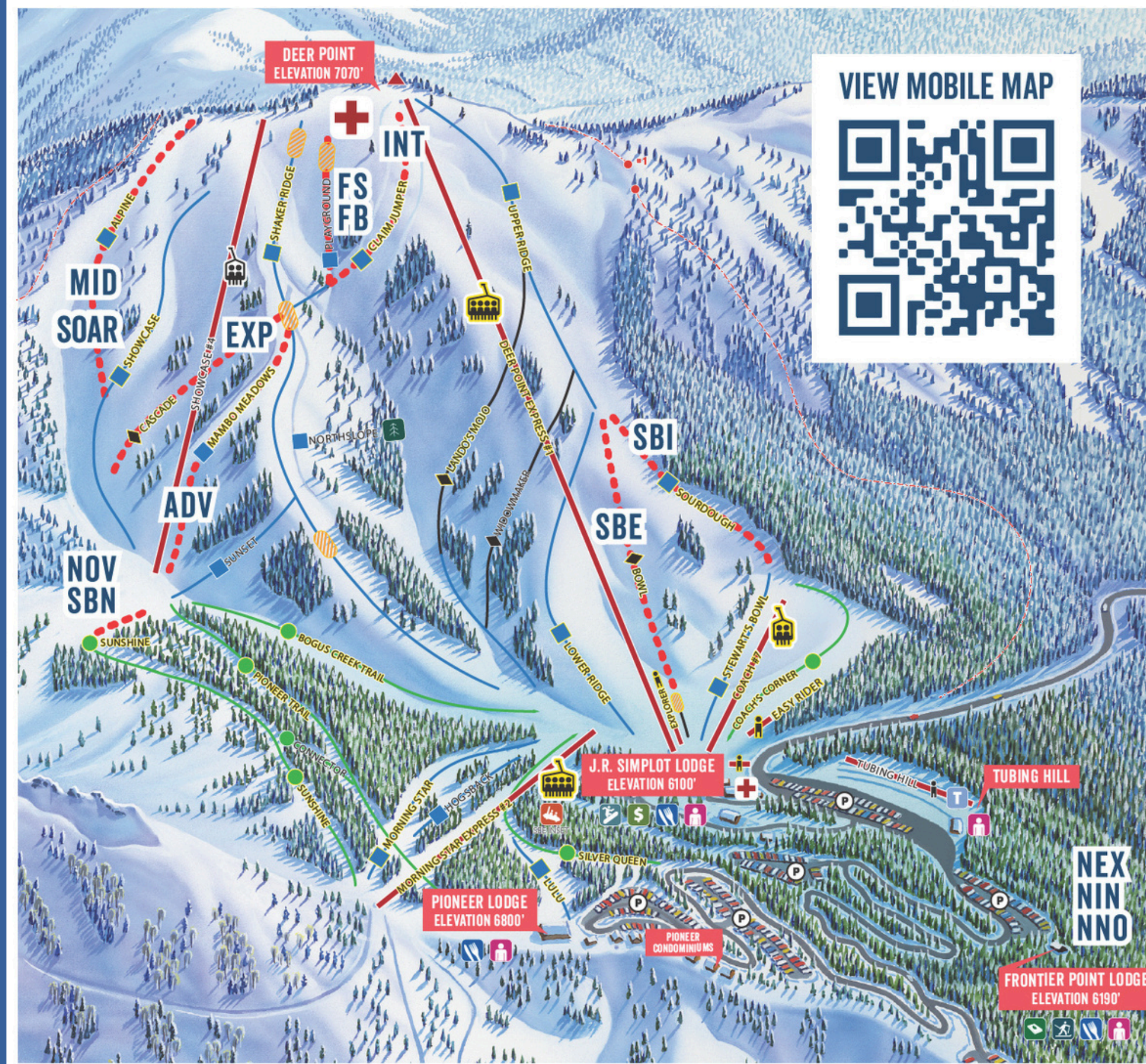

- Locations and times – go to the Bogus Basin website and select Getting Here and scroll down. First come first served.

Day Passes and Discounts

Mountain Passes \$29.00/day (plus tax) \$30.74 including tax

Students on the school roster are guaranteed a day pass on race days

- This day pass is good from Open to Close on the mountain
- All Day Passes will be purchased on-line
- Parents of students without a Season Pass will be emailed a link that will be used to enable you to purchase tickets for School Race Program Days at the reduced price.
- Plan on spending up to 15 minutes registering on the Bogus Basin website when setting up your account
- After you register you will be able to reload your student's media card/day pass, and it will be much faster

Day Pass Media/Card Information

Online Ticket Purchase & Redemption Process

Step 1: Purchase tickets online

You'll receive a secure URL at a later date. From that link you will:

Create a guest profile and upload a photo

Select ticket quantity and dates

Sign the waiver

Complete your purchase

Step 2: Save your confirmation email

The confirmation email includes your receipt and a QR code. Make sure you can access the QR code when you're on the mountain, either printed or saved on your device (cell service can be untrustworthy).

Step 3: Pick up your ticket

Location: ICCU Plaza in the Bogus Creek Base Area, formerly Simplot Lodge

Get Ticket

Scan your QR code at the kiosk/Pub.

Collect your ticket from the kiosk.

Enjoy the mountain!

Day Pass Media/Card Information Cont.

DO'S

Keep the ticket by itself in a jacket pocket.

Have the ticket in your pocket as you approach the lift gate.

Save your ticket for future visits and reload it online:

- Reload day tickets, summer activities, or next year's season pass/tickets on this card.

DON'TS

Do not hole punch the card.

Do not store it with your wallet, phone, keys, etc.

Do not carry other passes or RFID cards in the same pocket.

Do not throw away the card.

If the card is lost, it can be replaced for a \$10 fee.

All day passes will be issued as a media card that can be reloaded

Does the student have to be present to pick it or can someone pick it up for them?

NO, but the product will be picked up on the mountain from one of our ticket pubs. Whoever is picking up the access media card/ticket will need to scan the QR code at the pub. The pub/ticket card dispenser will spit out the card and the student/guest will go directly to the lift.

Media cards will only be available on the mountain at the ICCU Plaza – Outside Bogus Creek Lodge, formerly
Simplot Lodge

The cards can only be picked up and printed at the pubs/card dispensers located on the ICCU plaza (lower lodge patio). The parent will receive a QR code in a confirmation email after purchasing the ticket(s) online. They will need to give that QR code to the student and the student will scan the QR code on the mountain at a pub/ticket dispenser. The student/guest will go directly to the lift after they receive the card. I would advise that parents either print off the QR code or have the student take a picture of it on their phone. The student will only need to go to the pub on their first day as the tickets that are purchased will be on the card and any additional tickets can be reloaded onto that same card, there is no need to visit the patio or the pubs once the card is issued to the student.

Students in Need of Lessons and Equipment Student Training Access for Race Teams - START Program

- We will add a check box on the website only accessible and visible to Advisors to denote a student who qualifies for this program
 - Limited to the first 25 students registered by their Advisor
- Students must be registered in the program and if possible, participate in 3 races and Dotty Clark
 - Students will receive:
 - 3 free lessons – more if necessary
 - Free equipment
 - Free Day passes for the lessons and races
 - Deadlines to register a student:
 - 1st list for ski school deadline is 11/28/25
 - 2nd list and for ski school and final deadline is 12/10/25
