



SFYHA Tournament Volunteer Policy

Effective for the 2024-2025 season, the family of every SFYHA player participating in a home tournament is required to fulfill a specific number of DIBS tasks during the tournament weekend. Note that the requirement is to fulfill a number of DIBS tasks, not hours; the nature and time value of the DIBS task are not relevant to this requirement.

- Squirt Tournament: 3 DIBS Tasks
- PeeWee Tournament: 4 DIBS Tasks
- Bantam Tournament: 3 DIBS Tasks

Only a player whose parent is coaching in that tournament, whose parent is the Team Coordinator of a team playing in the tournament, or whose parent is serving as the team's Tournament Coordinator for that tournament, is exempt from this requirement. To clarify, a player on Squirt Orange 1 whose parent is coaching Squirt Orange 1, or whose parent is serving as Squirt Orange 1's Team Coordinator or Tournament Coordinator is exempt from this requirement. A player on Squirt Orange 1 whose parent is a coach or Tournament Coordinator for any team other than Squirt Orange 1, is a Board Member, League Manager at any level, League Supervisor at any level, Team Coordinator of any team, or serves SFYHA in any other volunteer capacity is **not** exempt from this requirement.

At the onset of the season, teams will receive their respective tournament schedule and notification that tournament DIBS are posted. Families will have one week to register for the requisite number of DIBS tasks. At the expiration of the week, Team Coordinators will confirm to the team, Cherry Hunter, and the Tournament Director, that all players are in compliance with the rule. Volunteers will check in at the tournament registration table for DIBS tasks throughout the tournament weekend, which will allow the Tournament Committee to monitor compliance with this requirement and to ensure all tournament DIBS are fulfilled. Failure of any player's family to comply with this requirement will result in that player being ineligible to play in the tournament.

This Tournament Volunteer requirement is a *minimum* level of commitment. SFYHA families are encouraged to volunteer for additional DIBS tasks as necessary to successfully host your player's tournament. The time value of all DIBS tasks performed during the tournament weekend will count towards the player's 2024-2025 Volunteer Hours requirement.
