Welcome/Introductions:

- Board member search update – the Board needs a minimum of four members to legally function, but ideally will have at least six to seven members to spread out the work. Seeking to fill President, Treasurer, Social Media/Communications, Spirit Wear Coordinator, and an Auction Chair for next year's auction. Aside from Treasurer and Membership, responsibilities could be divvied somewhat across the various roles, as needed. Any elected position can be held jointly by two people.
