**What is a Hit-a-Thon?** Players compete to hit a baseball the farthest with prizes with prizes given to the top player in each division. There are also prizes awarded to the top fundraisers: Top three players in fundraising and the team that raises the most.

**Why a Hit-a-Thon?** We were looking for something simple that allowed players the possibility to collect smaller dollar amounts (if desired) from a potentially larger pool. Since there is no fixed cost or perishable items to deliver, players can now collect donations from friends and relatives regardless of where they live. We also felt that a hit-a-thon would help build a sense of community amongst the league by creating a fun event for all to enjoy.

**How do players collect pledges?** Each player has their own web page on [99pledges.com](http://99pledges.com) to share via email or social media. Donations can be made on the website via credit or debit card. Players also have the option to collect cash or check donations and submit manually.

**How much will each player need to raise?** We are asking each player to set a minimum of a \$50 fundraising goal. The more you raise the better chance you have to win a prize!

**When is the hit-a-thon scheduled for?** The hit-a-thon is scheduled for April 25, 2020 starting at 5:00PM.

**Why do we need a fundraiser at all?** Sunnyvale National Little League works hard to provide the best experience for the kids while keeping our registration fees low and in some cases offer scholarships. Annual costs include field permits, baseballs, equipment and materials to prep the fields prior to games. Additionally we repair and replace catchers gear, batting tees, helmets and sound systems for announcing games.
