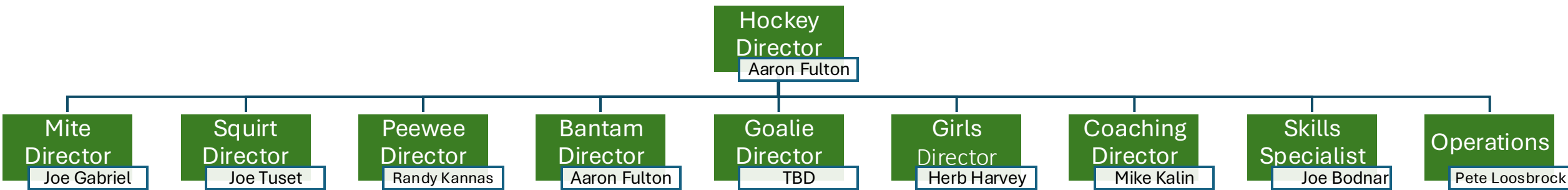


The Player Development Committee (PDC) at EVHA is responsible for the following:

---



Eastview Hockey Association (EVHA) is a non-profit organization dedicated to providing a fun and educational experience for the children residing in the Eastview High School Attendance area or who are eligible to play in the EVHA who wish to play ice hockey.

Our curriculum stresses basic skills, encourages team play, sportsmanship, and strives for fair playing time for all players.

The individuals who teach this curriculum, in all cases, have completed one or more courses in the USA Hockey Coaches' Education Program (CEP).

EVHA's coaches and Board of Directors, through such things as our Code of Conduct, also are committed to teaching players to respect their opponents and the officials.

- Bantam & Pee wee Tryouts Start This Weekend! Squirts Start **Oct 3rd** (goalies) and **5th** (skaters)  
Knock out your DIBS by volunteering to help with Tryouts! We have lots of open slots...particularly for Locker Room Monitors
  - Check the website for dates and group session postings
  - The primary goal of tryouts is to ensure players are placed at the most appropriate level
  - Will include scrimmages against outside associations (closed to parents like all tryout sessions)
  - All traveling players are required to try out
  - Please familiarize yourself with the tryout policies found here:

  - Myth Busting:
    - No EVHA coach, PDC or board member is allowed to view tryouts when they have a child participating
    - We use 3<sup>rd</sup> party evaluators, and it is a purely data-driven selection
    - There is no preferential treatment given to anyone. Participants are simply anonymized numbers in a spreadsheet

# EVHA Traveling Team Parents Meeting

## Traveling Team Managers

---



- One Manager per team
- Manage Team's Discretionary Finances (*not all teams do this...parents vote*)
- Assist coach in scheduling scrimmages, coordinating referee scheduling for scrimmages and ice time changes
- Coordinate with EVHA Ice Coordinator/Administrator
- Distribute and collect raffle tickets
- Team communications (schedule changes, etc.)
- Help with team coordination on picture night
- Coordinate Game-Day Parent Volunteer Jobs (Clock, Scorekeeper, Penalty Box, Locker Room Monitors) – These do NOT qualify for volunteer hours)
- Fulfill tourney requirements (roster submission, verify hotel block, etc.)

# EVHA Traveling Team Parents Meeting

## Fair Play Policy

---



- Squirts/10U - Equal playing time required – No Exceptions
- Peewees/12U - Equal playing time with coach discretion in certain situations (e.g. final few minutes of close games)
- Bantams/15U/Jr Gold - Equal playing time with more coach discretion than Peewee/12U. May have specialty lines but all players should get opportunities to play on special team positions throughout the regular season
- Goalies should be given equal playing time over the course of the season. Coach discretion on how to manage (e.g. whole game rotations/partial game rotations) Goalies can be rotated out of normal sequence for certain situations (e.g. playoffs).
- Teams can restrict playing time due to violation of team rules or attendance concerns.

## Volunteering (DIBs)

---



- All families are required to complete 8 hours of volunteering
- Volunteer policy available on the website (handbook)
- How to meet your required hours:
  - Check DIBs for roles/opportunities
  - Coaches
  - Team Managers
  - Concessions
  - Hosted Tournaments
  - More...



There are 45 DIBs spots available for Tryouts...mostly in the form of Male LRMs

- Locker Room Monitoring and Team Manager roles require background check
- Many board committees need help
- Note: *Game Day Duties DO NOT qualify (Timekeeper, scorekeeper, penalty box)*

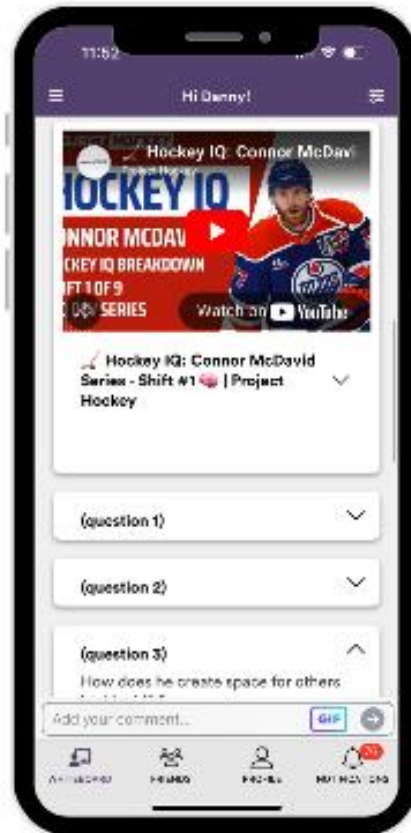
