SASA is a non-profit competitive youth soccer club whose primary focus is to provide a total, well rounded and positive soccer experience for the player, coach and parent. For those who fill positions such as board member, officer, employee or an independent contractor observance of SASA’s rules and procedures is required.

It is SASA’s policy to maintain the highest legal and ethical standards. Our members support SASA because they trust us to be good stewards of their resources while adhering to such legal and ethical standards. Our reputation for honesty and excellence requires the careful observance of all applicable laws and regulations.

Anyone who violates this Code is subject to discipline, up to and including removal from the program and/or loss of employment.

In support of SASA’s high standards, the following behavior will not be tolerated.

1. Abusive language.
2. Possession or use of illegal drugs on SASA’s property or reporting to a SASA function while under the influence of drugs.
3. Bringing dangerous or unauthorized materials such as explosives, firearms (unless by sworn law enforcement officer), weapons or other similar items onto SASA’s property.
4. Discourtesy or rudeness to a fellow participant, staff member or volunteer.
5. Verbal, physical or visual harassment of another participant, staff member or volunteer.
6. Actual or threatened violence toward any individual or group.
7. Conduct endangering the life, safety, health or well-being of others.
8. Failure to follow any SASA policy or procedure.
9. Bullying or taking unfair advantage of any participant.
