

USABL Umpire Ambassador Program:

If you meet certain criteria (defined below) you will be considered for USABL Ambassador status which means even higher pay. Breakdown of the criteria is below.

Purpose of this program is to reward the umpires who are higher level and meet the criteria. Additionally, they will be an example for the upcoming umpires and willing to help teach/guide new umpires to keep our umpire community strong! Having this program will allow the newer umpires to have even more support.

Criteria for USABL Umpire Ambassador:

- Attend at least 1 of the training/evaluation sessions and work at least 1 evaluation game.
 - a. Note: there may be exceptions made on a case by case basis.
- Own and wear the full USABL uniform and have your Profile picture on Arbiter preferably with umpire uniform on.
- Know the rules and mechanics required for the levels you work.
- Always punctual.
- Have the demeanor and game management skills needed to handle coaches and parents acting out of line.
- You are flexible to assignment changes.
- Have at least 100 games under your belt.
- Overall someone we want to put on the field as often as possible to positively represent the USABL brand and sport.
- Willing to train newer or developing umpires on an ongoing basis.
- You are someone who fellow umpires want to work with.
- USABL is a priority for you over other organizations.
