



Builder Award

The Ontario Volleyball Hall of Fame honours athletes, teams, coaches, officials, and builders who have had a significant impact on volleyball in Ontario. Inductees exemplify the best in the history of the sport in our province.

Eligibility & Selection Criteria:

Builder Category

- An Ontarian who has served in the Province of Ontario for a minimum of 20 years and made significant contributions in multiple categories (i.e. as an athlete, Coach, Official, and/or administrator), with a focus on the development and delivery of volleyball in Ontario.
- Accomplishments that may be considered include, but are not limited to:
 - History of committed involvement in the sport and performance
 - Attained a high level of excellence and ongoing dedication to the building of athletes, teams, or the sport itself
 - Extraordinary contributions to the development and delivery of volleyball programs or events in Ontario
 - Commitment to the sport of volleyball as demonstrated by years of service and significance of contributions
- An individual may only receive this award once in their lifetime
- Must have been an OVA member during their years of service
- A sports organization may not be inducted into the Ontario Volleyball Hall of Fame in any category. Individuals representing an organization are permitted for induction.
