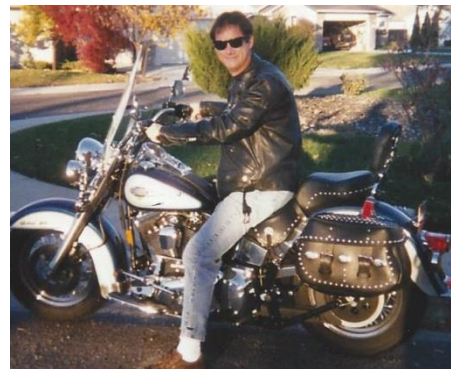


Ski Swap

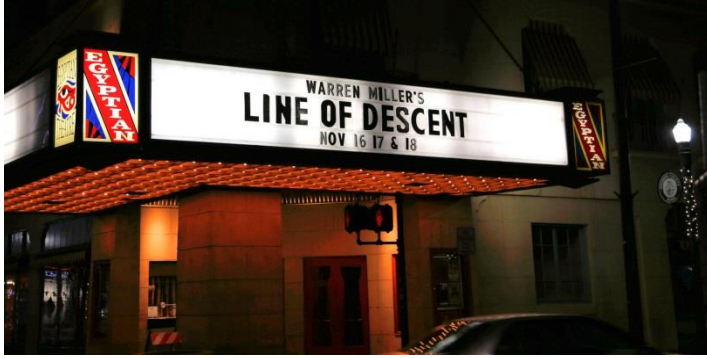

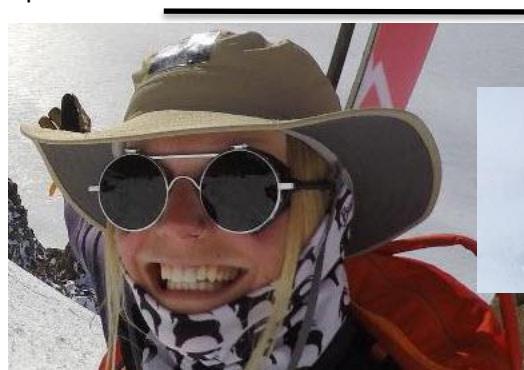
