PL football families,

I am excited to have our kids back in pads and preparing for our first weeks games. I continue to advocate for more fans and was outvoted yesterday to provide a state playoff experience. I hope we can make the best of the situation and be as positive (also Covid-19 negative) as possible for our players.

### Games

Each level will have six regular season games. The Varsity level will play a section tournament that could provide an additional three games. The game schedules for all levels is attached to this email.

### Spectators

The coaching staff is working to identify up to 60 “varsity ready” players. The families of those 60 players will receive an email with information on how to purchase a home pass (good for all 3 home games) and away game tickets online. (\$42 for one ticket for all 6 games) Families of varsity ready players are allowed to purchase up to two tickets each. (Total of \$84) Tickets to away games should be picked up in the activity office the week of the game starting at Noon on Mondays. The activity office is open from 8-4 and is now located just inside the new main entrance next to the upper PLHS parking lot. Varsity families will check in at the main pass gate for home games. Please have your ID ready. The name and number of the pass needs to match the name and number on our pass list. You will only need to provide a ticket to enter away games.

For our 9A, 9B, 10A and JV games, athletes will be allowed up to two spectators each. Please adhere to this request. Most lower level games will not be fenced off. I do not plan to do a pass list or a check in process for lower level games. If the honor system fails to work, I will implement a pass list and check in system for all games. The following is required if you plan to attend games.

1. We are allowed 250 total fans at an outdoor game (including visiting fans)
  2. Do not attempt to share, copy or duplicate tickets or passes
  3. Limit 2 spectators per athlete for all games

4. Must wear a masks anytime you're inside of 6 feet of someone else or walking to/from the field
5. Practice safe social distancing (6 feet from non-family members)
6. Parents are not allowed on the sidelines unless volunteering to work chains at home games
7. After the game, please exit the facility ASAP. Do not gather and wait to speak to players.
8. Parking at Varsity games will be restricted to those on the pass list. Tail gaiting is prohibited.

### **Web Stream**

All Varsity games will be streamed live online by the host school. All home game streams can be found online at [www.plhsactivities.org](http://www.plhsactivities.org) Please click the "in progress" game on the scoreboard ribbon across the top of the home page. We are not able to stream the lower level games. All games will be accessible via HUDL after the game through the players log in.

### **Transportation to games**

We will provide two buses to all lower level games. We will provide three buses to varsity games. Athletes are allowed to drive or ride with a parent to or from games. Please let your coach know if your son does not plan to ride the bus to or from games. Players must wear a mask or a gaiter mask on the bus at all times.

### **Covid-19 protocols:**

Athletes will be placed into practice and game pods. Movement between levels & teams will be restricted. Players will be provided two gaiter masks. A gaiter mask should be worn at every practice and game. When players are in a huddle or on the sideline the gaiter mask should be worn in way that covers the mouth and the nose.

Players need to social distance whenever possible on the field and sideline. Players will be allowed locker room access in waves by pod. Players
