RULES AND REGULATIONS**

Games will start 15 minutes early if possible. Please be ready

- 1 Minot Hockey Boosters will supply warm up pucks for all games
- 2 Minot Hockey Boosters Association will not be responsible for injuries or accidents.
- 3 Tournament will be conducted under USA Hockey Rules.
- 4 All players must be on their perspective USA/CHA certified rosters, and all players must be USA Hockey or equivalently insured.
- 5 Tournament chairman will have final decision on any situation not covered in the rules, and this is a "NO PROTEST" tournament.
- 6 All games will consist of three 15-minute, stop time. There will be a six (6) minute warm-up that will start as soon as the ice has been resurfaced. The ice will be resurfaced after every 2nd period and game. There will be a 2 minute break in between periods. The clock will run if any team is leading by 6 or more goals in the 3rd period.
- 7 Pool Play
Will receive three (3) points for a win, zero (0) points for a loss, and one (1) point for an overtime loss or tie. (2) Points for an Overtime Win. Overtime will be 5 mins of 3 on 3. If still tied it ends in a tie.
Rules for determining final standing ties, to declare a higher seed.
Applies in order:
 1. Head to head
 2. +/-Goal differential (goals scored minus goals allowed in all games. 8 goals Max Spread)
 3. Fewest goals allowed. (Total all games)
 4. Most goals scored. (Total all games)
- 8 Locker rooms will be assigned and please leave them clean.
- 9 Spectators:
 - A: Locker-room hallway is for coaches, managers, and players only.
 - B: If you are asked to leave a game by an on/off ice official we will abide by the officials recommendations for your suspension.
- 10 Have fun, make noise and cheer wildly in support of your team: (no air horns) but please, respect the game officials, all fans, and players.
- 11 Trophies will be awarded to placing teams.
