



## **Rink Protocol**

**October 15, 2020**

Woodbridge Community Center is currently open to the general public with restrictions. We will be open to pre-registered skaters and/or small private rental groups/camps using the ice. The following parent/player protocols will be in place at the WCC and must be adhered to:

- All PARENTS AND PLAYERS **MUST WEAR MASKS AT ALL TIMES** when entering the building at the Woodbridge Community Center.
- All warm-ups must take place outside prior to entering the building
- **All parents must sign a COVID-19 Waiver for any minor child under the age of 18 years of age in order to enter the facility**
- **Players are not permitted to roam the building and must remain in the ice rink at all times**
- All rink patrons will use the front entrance of the Community Center. Proceed to table for temperature check and series of **COVID-19\*** questions. You will then proceed directly into the ice rink.
- **Attempt to arrive at the rink no more than 10-15 minutes before your time slot.**
- Only **one** parent will be allowed in the building for skaters **12 years of age and under** to assist with skates. Once the skater is on the ice, parents are asked to leave through the front entrance and to wait outside the building.
- All athletes **(12 years of age and under)** are recommended to arrive dressed & put their skates on in rink area designated by WCC staff. Additional benches will be put out six feet apart. Bags are to be left in this area.
- **All Skaters ages 13 and older** should be dropped off for their session while parents wait outside in their vehicle. **These players** will be directed to a designated changing area after following the **COVID-19** procedure stated above. **\*PLEASE SEE 3<sup>RD</sup> BULLET POINT REGARDING COVID-19 Waiver form**
- If an athlete does not feel well, **STAY HOME**. Any red flag means no participation
- Athletes bring their own water bottles **(water fountains are not recommended for use)**
- Team coming on the ice stays in their assigned area until Zamboni doors are closed, then proceed to the ice.

- Once team is on the ice, previous teams must leave building immediately after session is over
- Coaches must wear masks on the bench, as well as off ice officials in the scorers box during games
- Coaches/Referees are encouraged to wear masks while on the ice but it is not mandatory at this time

The Woodbridge Community Center has maintained rigorous cleaning, sanitizing and disinfecting procedures. All employees will be wearing appropriate protective equipment during their shifts. Hand sanitizers are located throughout the facility.

Protocols will be adjusted with the ongoing effects of COVID-19 and with Executive Order 187 mandated by the Governor of the State of New Jersey or the orders of the President of Wolfpack Hockey Club. These changes, modifications and protocols will be enforced at all times.

As we prepare and move forward with Phase II of reopening, please understand our policies and procedures are in place to ensure the safety and well-being of our community. We thank you for your cooperation and patience during this process. We will be working diligently to keep our skaters, coaches, customers and employees safe while providing a fun and exciting environment for skaters.
