

Panther Paws Instructional Youth Hockey



LEARN THE GAME !

Our Panther Paws classes cover skating and hockey basics for ages 3 and up. Classes meet 30-60 minutes and the time is dedicated to skill development through drills and on-ice games. Panther Paws consists of 6 levels or groups where skaters begin in Group 1 and progress as their skating and hockey skills improve. Groups 1-3 end their session with a cross-ice hockey game on the main arena. Groups 4-6 play a cross-ice game mid-session and at the end of the session.

All students who are NEW to the Panther Paws program must register for Group 1. Based on their skill level, they may be reassigned to a higher group (**Additional fees apply for moving up groups**).

A hockey helmet with a cage is required for Groups 1-2. Group 3 requires a hockey helmet with cage, hockey gloves, and hockey stick. Groups 4, 5 and 6 require full equipment with exception to shoulder pads. Hockey skates can be rented weekly at the front desk.
