

## MRCA STUDENT AWARDS

## ACADEMIC AWARDS

### Team Academic Awards (Beginning in 2019)

Team Academic Awards will follow the MSHSCA guidelines and the mentor must be a member of the MRCA

- A. Gold Award: GPA of 3.75-4.0
- B. Silver Award: GPA of 3.50-3.74

MSHSCA will supply a plate to be added to the Academic Plaque already supplied to each school.

Teams will use the GPA for each student in grades 10-12 available at the conclusion of the most recent grading period. Deadline for submission is April 1 of the current build season.

### Individual Academic Awards (Beginning in 2019)

Nominated players must:

1. Be in grades 10-12
2. Be an important contributor to the team
3. Have a cumulative GPA of 3.80 or higher
4. Mentor must be a current member of MRCA
5. Mentor must submit online by the deadline date of April 1 of the current build season
6. No MSHSL violations in the current or previous school year
7. Students will receive a certificate

### ALL STATE (Beginning in 2022)

Each team may nominate deserving individuals to be recognized as members of the All-State Robotics Team. Mentors must complete and submit the application (currently being developed) by the deadline in order to have eligible team members considered for this award. Fifteen (15) students will be selected annually for this award. The selection committee will be composed of representatives from each Hub/Section.

1. Nominated student must be a senior
2. Nominated student must have been involved in FRC for three years
3. Nominated student must have NO MSHSL violations
4. Nominated student must have excelled in one of the following categories
  - a. Programming
  - b. Marketing/Media
  - c. Design
  - d. Build Team
  - e. Leadership

Students will receive a plaque at the MSHSL Tournament in May.
