- AA Coach Selection: The application period opened May 19th with a June 1st close date.
   Following interviews conducted by the AA Coach selection committees for each division, the
   following coaches were announced: U19AA – Eric Lavoy, U16AA Joel Lajoie, U14AA – Darcy

- 2. Coach Selection U10 U19: The coach application deadline was September 2<sup>nd</sup>, we received 38 coaching applications in total. Following interviews conducted by the Coach selection committees, where required, the following head coaches for each team were announced.
- 3. U10 U19 Coach Selection SARA had a total of 30 teams from U10 Step1 to U19AA and Open, with a total of 186 hard carded Head Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Managers, One Ice Assistants, Trainers and Junior coaches.
- 4. CSI Clinic SARA hosted a CSI (Community Sport Initiation) clinic in association with RAB on October 20<sup>th</sup>
- 5. CI Clinic SARA hosted a CI (Competition Introduction) clinic in association with RAB on November 8<sup>th</sup> 10<sup>tt</sup>
- 6. U12 U19 Coaches and Managers meeting On September 25<sup>th</sup> SARA hosted out annual U12 U19 Coaches and Managers meeting. This meeting provides an opportunity for coaches and managers to receive information pertaining to the new season and discuss any changes. This meeting weas well attended.
- 7. U10 Coaches and Manager meeting On October 1<sup>st</sup>, SARA hosted our annual U10 Coaches and Managers meeting. This was a significant year for changes for the U10 program. The meeting was well attended.
- 8. Coach Mentor Night On December 19<sup>th</sup> SARA hosted it's first Coach Mentor Night. SARA brought together a team of 5 SARA coaches with a great mix of experience and coaching perspectives to lead a number of small group discussions. This format provided the opportunity for coaches from all division to get together to discuss their experiences and provide insight and guidance to on another. A total of 30 coaches participated in the event and those who attended were provided practice plans and drills from our 5 mentor coaches to take back to their own teams.

Our coaches and their staff all did a great job overall of meeting their requirements for approval of their hardcards through RAB by the December deadline.
