GM Report- James Soesbee

-We now have a good number of referees in the program, and we would like to continue with monthly referee education so they will continue to improve

-Jerseys- U4/U5 will be keeping the old uniforms. Rec & Academy will be getting new uniforms in the fall

Assistant GM- Gary Boreham

-Recreational registration will begin June 1st, 2023

-Academy registration may be pushed back to July 1st, 2023

Academy Director- Mark Howard & Mitch Sowerby

-Presented an Academy proposal of a new tiered structure. Elite Academy will be teams 1-3. ESC academy will be teams 4 and below. ESC Pre-Academy will be the youngest age which will be the 2018's. Board was in favor of the new tiered structure

Rec Chair- Shawn Wiley

-proposal of recreational director position. Responsibilities would include coaching development, player development, conducting coaching sessions and parent education. No decision has been made on adding this position

Complex Coordinator- Dan Weinmeister

-Bottle filler/ fountain installed at east concession with top soccer grant funds

-currently in the process of aerating the complex

-top dressing all fields and heavy top dressing 7 fields (3, 6, 7, 10, 14, 15 and 18)

-sprigging Tahoma Bermuda on many fields where we have goose grass. 6,7 and 10 sprigged as of now. Other fields will follow as sod cutting allows

- sprigging and top dressing should be complete by 7/1 possibly even mid-June
- currently in the process of fertilizing the entire complex. Additional fertilizer will be applied in July
- construction moving along and should have structures started within the next month
- replacing sprinkler heads and fixing leaks as needed at the complex
