



2020 EASTERN ADULT SECTIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS "KNOW BEFORE YOU GO"



REGISTRATION:

The registration desk is located right inside the front door of the skating club. Registration desk will open at 8am on Friday morning before the start of the competition. Saturday and Sunday, registration will open at 7:00 am. All skaters are expected to be in the arena 45 minutes prior to the start of their scheduled event.

Skaters will only need to check in at the registration desk once in order to receive their credentials. Skaters are then required to check in with the ice monitor before each practice ice session and competitive event. The schedule can be viewed on EMS in your skater/coach portal.

PARKING:

There is a main parking lot as well as an overflow parking lot on County Line.

CREDENTIALS AND ADMISSION:

All credentials must be picked up at the event registration desk.

Only coaches who are designated by their skaters in EMS and are fully compliant within U.S. Figure Skating and SafeSport guidelines may receive a credential. Coaches must show photo ID at the registration desk and pick up their own credential.

Credentials must be worn at all times at the competition facility and are non-transferable. Replacement Fee for lost credential is \$35.

TICKET PRICE

Admission tickets are required for all events. Admission tickets are \$10/daily or \$15/all event pass. Tickets may be purchased at the registration window.

PROGRAMS:

- Official Event Program: \$10
- Event Pin: \$5

PRACTICE ICE:

Unofficial Practice Ice sessions are still available. If you have not already purchased your sessions (one per event allowed), please do so on the EMS site. Practice ice sessions can be purchased through EMS through 3:00 pm on Thursday, March 5th. After this time, any remaining available practice slots will be for sale on-site beginning Friday morning.

LOCKER ROOMS:

A Ladies/Girls locker room is available along with a Men's locker room.

U.S. Figure Skating Locker Rooms/Changing Areas Policy for Adult Figure Skating Competitions: Only adult athletes competing at the adult figure skating event are allowed in the Locker Rooms/Changing Areas. The use of any recording and photographic devices inside a Locker Room/Changing Area is strictly prohibited. Any violation of this policy is punishable under the U.S. Figure Skating SafeSport policy and U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook.

MEDICAL TEAM:

Our Medical Team of certified Athletic Trainers will be located in Rink 1 in Locker Room OJB on the Lobby side of the rink just past the bleachers and underneath them (Opposite end of Men's locker room). This will allow easy access to the outside door on the south end of the rink in case emergency medical transport is necessary.

VIDEOGRAPHY:

Vision Productions is the official videographer for the 2020 Eastern Adult Sectional Figure Skating Championships. All participants will receive a complimentary digital download of each of their performances.

STARTING ORDERS & RESULTS:

All starting orders and results will be posted inside the Club's lower lounge.

MEDALS AND AWARDS:

Awards schedule is posted around the rink area. Awards will be presented in the external tent attached to the building. Medals are provided for first through fourth place finishers.

SPECTATOR CONDUCT:

As a reminder, no items of any kind are to be thrown on the ice. Violation of this rule may subject the offender to ejection from the arena. Please throw celebratory items into the designated "tossie" basket which will be carried by a sweeper around the arena.

SPECIAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS:

Adult Special Achievement Awards will be awarded in Championship Adult Gold, Championship Masters Int/Nov and Championship Adult Jr/Sr freeskate events at the Adult Sectional Championships to:

- * the skater in each group with the highest **Skating Skills** mark total
- * the skater in each group with the highest **Performance** mark total
- * the skater in each group with the highest point total for their **Spins**
- * **Every** skater who earns at least one **+3** GOE from any judge (only one award per program)

Results will be posted with the event results and skaters should pick up their Achievement Award at the registration desk.
