President Report

- Motion to approve August Board Minutes. Motion passes
- Southwest League (grades 9-12)
 - Motion to approve pricing for SW League at \$215 regular and \$108 scholarship and new MYAS Rising Stars travel league at \$250 regular and \$125 scholarship. Motion passes.
 - Motion to approve \$500 stipend for Rising Stars coaches. Motion passes.
 - Rising Stars league will be an option for teams who have travel basketball experience but are not playing on a high school team. Teams will practice 2x/week with 2 games/week.
 - SW League teams will continue to practice 1x week and play 1 game/week.
 - Andy will advertise via HHS newsletter, email blast to former travel players, word of mouth. Self-assembled teams.
