Standard Registration	<p>Standard Registration is from <b>September 17, 2025, through November 2nd, 2025, at 11:45 PM.</b></p> <p>*Player uniforms are included in this fee.  <b>HS Boys:</b> 2 shorts, 2 jerseys, 1 shooter shirt &amp; 1 pinnie.  <b>HS Girls:</b> 2 skorts, 2 jerseys, 1 pinnie &amp; 1 shooter shirt.  <b>MS/Y Boys:</b> 1 pinnie, 1 shooter shirt &amp; 1 pair of shorts.  <b>MS/Y Girls:</b> 1 pinnie, &amp; 1 shooter shirt.</p>	<p>High School - \$700.00</p> <p>HS Bag Fee- \$ 125.00 (REQUIRED for new HS players. OPTIONAL for returning HS players.)</p> <p>Youth/Middle School - \$375.00</p>
Payment Plan	<p>For the 2026 season we are <b>allowing</b> a payment plan. The plan will allow payments to be made in 3 installments. <b>The 1st payment of \$234 (plus \$125 for HS new player bag) is due at the time of registration (Nov 2<sup>nd</sup>).</b> The 2nd payment of \$234 is due by Feb. 1<sup>st</sup>. The 3<sup>rd</sup> payment of \$234 is due by <b>March 1<sup>st</sup>.</b></p> <p>HS Bag is not part of the payment plan and the \$125 is due date of registration with first payment.</p> <p><b>Payment plan participants will be required to serve in Volunteer Opportunities. (A minimum of 4 hrs. per family will be required) Sign up at registration.</b></p>	<p>High School - \$700.00</p> <p>HS Bag Fee- \$ 125.00 (REQUIRED for new HS players. Post Standard Registration	<p>Late Registration is after the <b>November 2nd, 2025,</b> deadline. **HIGH SCHOOL BAG FEE & UNIFORM PLAYER PACK CHANGES**

The cost of uniforms will be included in the standard registration fee. The only additional charge for high school players will be the High School Bag Fee which is \$ 125.00. This bag is **mandatory** for all new boys & girls high school players. The HS bag is **optional** for returning high school players. New uniforms are purchased every 2 years. This will be the second season for the current uniform so only new players will receive new uniforms. All players will receive new pinnies and shooter shirts every year.

**REFERRAL BONUS & MULTIPLE PLAYER DISCOUNT**

We offer a \$25.00 referral bonus to players who refer a new player to our program. (Only 1 per player) We offer a \$45.00 discount for parents registering more than one player! See registration for details. (1 per family)

**USA LACROSSE MEMBERSHIP**
