

Taylor High School Athletic Booster Club Board General Meeting Minutes from October 3, 2022

Officer Reports:

Treasurer: Michael reported financials for the month of September will be updated and reported on the website later this week.

VP Fundraising: Spirit night at Layne's \$22 and waiting on Red River BBQ.
