Practice Protocols

(Last Update: 1.11.2021)

Players and Rostered Staff:

- Participants/Staff/All Others should refrain from congregating at the front entrance of the rink.
- Masks should be worn in the immediate vicinity of the rink.
- Teams will now be allowed in 15 minutes prior to their practice start time. HISC recommends buying walkable skate guards to put on skates prior to entering the facility.
- Each team will have a designated area assigned by a HISC Staff member and they must remain there until ready to take the ice.
- There are four areas in HISC for teams to put on skates/remove guards:
 - Lobby
 - Balcony
 - Back Room (by managers' offices)
 - Front row of the bleachers.
- All participants must wear a mask at all times EXCEPT while on the ice.
- **No bags allowed in the rink.** Bags should be kept outside of the facility locked in vehicles (HYHA/Hagerstown Ice and Sports Complex does not accept any responsibility for any missing items).
- Goalies will be allowed access to a locker room if needed no more than 15 min prior to start time.
- Once ready to take the ice, players may proceed to the designated rink entry door. All team personnel should remain as distanced as possible throughout this process.
- Once the practice has concluded, players will have 5 minutes to leave the building.
- Once off the ice, the helmet is removed and the mask/face covering is put back in place before removing skates.
- Skates should be removed (if needed), but no other undressing should occur in the facility (exception for goalies who have utilized a dressing room).
- Players and staff should vacate the building immediately, utilizing only the doors marked EXIT.

Spectators: (updated 1.11.2021)

- 1 parent/player may remain in the building. A mask must be worn at all times and social distancing of 6 ft is required if not from the same household.
- Parent/Guardian must sign in at the front desk when entering the facility and exit when the
