Practices:

Football:

- Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday from 6:00-8:00 PM
- SJV (7th grade) and SV (8th grade) teams are able to practice 4 days a week Monday- Friday. Your head coach will determine what your 4th practice day will be on.
- Tackle Football players must come to practice with the appropriate attire. Helmet, mouth guard, cleats and pads (7 pad girdle and shoulder pads). Please wear practice pants or shorts, and a practice jersey over your shoulder pads. Please dress according to the weather. Players may wear long-sleeved shirts under their pads.
- Tackle football players must have three non-padded practices (helmets, cleats, mouth guard) before they can suit up in full gear.
- Flag football players must wear weather appropriate clothing, mouth guard, cleats, and flag belt (provided by league)
- Football players must attend 12 total practices before they are able to play in a game.

Cheer:

- Practices will be on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 6-8:00 PM.
- Cheerleaders should wear the following tennis shoes (cheer shoes preferred). On stunt days cheer should wear shorts (no shorter than mid-thigh). Leggings, shorts, and sweatpants may be worn on other practice days.
- **NO BBBB- No Butts, No Boobs, No Belly, NO Backs.** None of these areas of anybody's body will be shown during practice. (no crop tops or tying shirt to show midriff, no short shorts)
- On game days Cheerleaders should dress in their uniform, cheer shoes, and must have their backpack with them with the items listed on their bag.
- Each Cheerleader must attend 12 practices before they are able to cheer on the sideline.

Fundraising:

- Fundraising is not mandatory but greatly encouraged. Money raised by each fundraiser will go towards the franchises (scholarship, equipment, end of year banquet, help offset cost for both cheer and football).
