



Monthly Meeting Minutes

May 15, 2019

- 1) Meeting brought to order at 7:34 pm by Chris Kittredge
 - a) Review April 2019 Meeting Minutes – Motion to approve minutes. Minutes approved.

Need to have coaches meeting and get registration started. We received \$1,000 for donations from Bob Sullivan’s memorial. Will need to get thank you letters out for the donations.
- 2) Secretary Report (Jillian Woodcock) – Have the head tax calculation to send out and get approved by all sports and also have the Stewart’s grant allocation to send out to get approved.
- 3) Treasurers Report (Laura Prouty-absent) – No report.
- 4) Communications Director Report (no director) – Everyone should have access to change anything on the website. Suggestion is that the prospective sport should stay within their sport. Chris can show how to do things. Think about setting up another meeting for a tutorial, such as in the library. Did the clinic to see what kind of interest there is. Because there is already a structure in place for the tournaments locally, feel that it will not be a problem having teams to play against. If there is concern about having enough kids sign up, then we can always have a cutoff and have a stopping point if there are not enough girls. A motion was made to have a probation period of a year. Motion was seconded. The Varsity coach is excited to see this happen. This connection will make it easier for when the girls to transition. There was an offer to provide financial assistance to get the program going. Will be 2 or 3rd grade to get going. '3/4 and 5/6 grade levels. Registrations will run through Sports Engine.
