

COVID-19 building use procedures:

**West Fargo Sports Arena (520 32<sup>nd</sup> Ave W, West Fargo, ND, 58078)**

**West Fargo Veterans Memorial Arena - VETS (1201 7<sup>th</sup> Ave E, West Fargo, 58078)**

- We ask that teams enter the building no earlier than 45 minutes before their game. Teams are allowed locker rooms for games. Locker rooms are assigned.
- Spectators to enter the building for ONLY games/scrimmages, no earlier than 15 minutes before game time, and must leave within 15 minutes of the game ending.
- We ask that Spectators not congregate in lobby or common areas after games and prefer waiting for their players outside after games.
- Water fountains are off, bottle fillers are available.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at the main entry.
- Showers will not be offered in the locker rooms.
- **The use of masks is REQUIRED for anyone that enters the building for the duration of their time in the building with the exception of when eating or drinking. Players and Coaches are also allowed to remove masks for games.**
- Practice social distancing guidelines as recommended by the CDC.

**Moorhead Sports Center (2400 4<sup>th</sup> Ave S, Moorhead, MN 56560)**

**(Follows Guidelines of Cullen Center)**

- Players/Teams will have use of the locker rooms. Separate player only staging areas will also be available in each rink for those not wanting to use the locker rooms. Chairs spaced according to social distancing guidelines. Locker rooms and staged areas will be sanitized after each use.
- Players to be dropped off no earlier 60 minutes before games.
- Players to be picked up no more than 15 minutes after practice/training or game is complete.
- Spectators to enter the building for ONLY games/scrimmages, no earlier than 15 minutes before game time, and must leave within 15 minutes of the game ending.
- Spectators limited to lobby areas, public restrooms, and bleachers to reduce interaction.
- **The use of masks is REQUIRED for anyone that enters the building for the duration of their time in the building with the exception of when eating or drinking. Players and Coaches are also allowed to remove masks for games.**
- Practice social distancing guidelines as recommended by the CDC.
- No use of water fountains.
- Signage will be displayed outlining advisable precautions (e.g., handwashing) from CDC.
- Added alcohol-based hand sanitizer stations will be available.
