

Admission: SLP Rec Center Capacity is 75 per game. All spectators must be registered in advance and visiting team athletic administration staff should send the list to Judy Koski at jkoski@bmschool.org by noon on Thursday 1/14.

Home team is allowed two spectators per rostered player. BSM parents must register their 2 spectators by filling out the google doc on the boy's hockey web page. Tuition Charge of \$7.00 per spectator

Visiting team is allowed one spectator per rostered player.

All Players and Spectators must clear the rink immediately after their game.

Protocols For the St. Louis Park Rec Center

Spectators: Spectators may enter building 15 minutes before game time. All spectators must watch the game from the top half of the bleachers (Above the yellow Line). Spectators will have to vacate the building within 5 minutes of the ending of the game. *In order for a Spectator to attend a high school game, they will have to sign up with their respective school to be put on the admittance list for the game.* Once the Spectators are in the facility they will not be allowed to come and go during the game or in between periods when the ice is being resurfaced. Once you leave the facility you will not be readmitted to the facility. *Should a Spectator have a player on the JV and Varsity teams, the Spectator will have to vacate the arena and return for the next game so long as the Spectator's name is on the list from the school for that game.*

Food will not be allowed to be brought into the facility for high school games.

Home JV Teams: Will arrive 30 minutes before game time. The home team will enter the arena through Front entrance. Team will use area sectioned off on the North side of the West Rink. (Across from Home bench). Home Locker Room and Locker Room H may be used as restrooms and for gear storage for periods one and two. JV teams will need to bring all bags & equipment out of locker rooms at start of period three.

Varsity Teams are not to enter until the 3rd period of JV has begun.

Visiting JV Teams: Will arrive 30 minutes before game time. The visiting team will enter the arena through the main Front entrance. Team will use area sectioned off on the south side of the West Rink. (Across from Visiting Bench). Visitors will have two locker rooms assigned to be used as restrooms and storage for periods one and two. JV teams will need to bring all bags & equipment out of locker rooms at start of period three.

Varsity Teams are not allowed to enter until the 3rd period of V has begun.

Site Manager will help direct teams.

Team Guidelines: Participants must come fully dressed, except for helmets, skates and gloves. Goalies must come half-dressed and will be allowed to bring in an equipment bag. No one will be allowed to change clothes anywhere in the building, including the restrooms. Each rink will have a dedicated waiting area adjacent to the rink where the Participants can put on their skates. Participants are expected to sit only in approved spaces on chairs or benches, marked with sticker, to put on their skates, or to wait for their ice time to start in order to maintain a minimum of 6 feet of social distance between themselves and other participants. Participants may bring their own water bottles already filled *fountains are available; encourage*

to bring own filled bottle)

Per the Executive Order 20-103, all Participants, Coaches and Spectators will be required to wear a cloth face mask upon entering the building and must continue to wear the mask during the entire time they are in the facility.

Resurfacing Schedule: During the JV Game the ice will be resurfaced only after period 2. Varsity Team will warm up on dirty ice following the JV game. Varsity games will have a resurface before the start of the game and after the end of every period.

Teams Leaving Facility: All team members will have 15 minutes to vacate the facility, using the same doors that they came in. *JV Team members will be not allowed to stay unless they are playing in the Varsity game right after their game.* If JV player is staying to play for the second game, they will have to wait in the bleacher area while the team area is sanitized for the next game.

Restroom Facilities: Each team will have the use of their own restrooms to use. There is no changing of clothes in the restrooms.

Game Officials: Officials may arrive 20 minutes prior to game time. *Officials must leave within 15 minutes after the end of the game.* Officials will be assigned to a locker room. Masks/Face coverings are required the entire time the official is in the facility. Officials are encouraged to dress as much as possible before entering the facility. Officials are not allowed to change clothes or shower. Officials will be allowed a small size gym bag, carried over the shoulder, to bring in skates & jersey.
