- a. Weight Room Improvements-
 - We have been talking about these upgrades for 2 years now. Last year, we contributed funds towards the flooring updates in the Fieldhouse weight room.
 - Football has covered the cost of doors and wall wraps to be installed (\$3,250.00)
 - After receiving multiple quotes, Vance has moved forward with fundraising. The total cost will be around \$125,000 with freight charges included. Vance has raised a significant amount of that through donors.
 - Vance is requesting how much CHS Athletic Booster Club can contribute towards this fundraising cause as he needs to put down a 50% deposit on this purchase in order to get it done this summer- which is the best time to make alterations to the weight room so it doesn't impact the sport's workout schedules.
 - Discussion:
 - Talked through what the quote includes and why it's a necessity and not aesthetic at all.
 - Considering which sports use the FH weight room
 - Considering breaking the project into two smaller quotes to ensure full payment on this summer's project.
 - Considering how much Coach Vance has gone out and raised on his own - talked through how impressive it is to raise that much money for the project.
 - So far no other sports have been asked to contribute towards the cause.
 - Discussed reaching out to sports who use the gym weight room to see what needs they might have there.
 - The President moves to vote on allocating \$20,000.00 towards the Field House weight room.
 - Everyone in favor.
 - No one opposed.
