### **Registrar's Report**

Dates and fees for the upcoming spring season were established by all present parties. Online registration will run from Jan 13<sup>th</sup> to Mar 1<sup>st</sup>. In-person on Feb 27<sup>th</sup> from 6 to 7pm. Late registration will run up until the first game of the season as slots are available. A \$15 late charge will be applied. Coaches meeting Mar 25<sup>th</sup> at 6pm.

Weather permitting, practice will start Apr 6<sup>th</sup>. Games will run from Apr 19<sup>th</sup> to Jun 14<sup>th</sup>. No games Memorial Day weekend. No spring tournament. It was suggested that any missed games be made up during the week. Extending the season past Jun 14<sup>th</sup> is too late into summer with families going on vacation.

U4 – U8 is \$25, U10 – U14 is \$35, U16 – U18 \$40. Players need their own black shorts and socks. Sponsored team T-shirts will be supplied by the league. Jen Yuhas requested that a new vendor be utilized as previous vendor was expensive and difficult to work with. All parties agreed to obtain a quote from Axelrad who is known by several of the board members.

Kevin reported that some of the sponsors from previous season did not make it onto the shirts and would need to be added this season. He added that any sponsor slots not filled would be covered by his auto repair shop.
