

Staff Follow Up From June Board Meeting

- Concussion protocol: I have reached out to Sanford Orthopedics Athletic Trainers. They have received our information for what we would need (#'s and ages of athletes, deadlines for baseline testing as end of summer, possible discounts for 501(c) 3 organizations, etc.). She is conferring with her administration and will issue us with a proposal as soon as possible. Our policy will be written to mirror our game plan with Sanford as it is developed.
- Meeting notifications: We have posted the next meeting date to the website and will post to Facebook and the Teams app. One week prior to each meeting with date, time, and location.
- USAG guidance on coach to student ratio: There is no specific guidance... We will continue to use a 1-10 coach to gymnasts ratio per our insurance policy
- Comp Open Gym: As a substitution to Open Gym time, we have coordinated with Ashleigh Gardner for the next two weeks to host group private lessons with the Optional level gymnasts (Kenzie is coordinating with the gymnasts for availability). We will plan on Comp Open Gyms to resume mid-July.
- High School Tuition: Jamie is running numbers to develop a system for the revamp of High School tuition. Our deadline for this is July 1st
- Summer Fundraisers: We have 3 now in planning progress. A Throw Back Leo and Warm Up Sale, A Car Wash (combined with High School and possibly Moe's Shaved Ice Snow Cones), and Participation in Family Day River walk, Information on dates/ times/ will be sent to membership as they are finalized.
- Sponsorships: I have contacted several options for scholarship and wall sponsorships and will update after the receipt of confirmation at the next BOD meeting.
- Optional Coach: Applicants will be interviewed this Thursday
- Budget Approval: To be completed reflecting new high school tuition rates at the July BOD meeting.
- Opening up the Foam Pit and spotting: We are expecting new guidance today. Based on that, we are anticipating opening the Pit and then beginning to spot following that, for the Comp. and Show programs only, on Wednesday of this week.

- Level 3 Vault system: We have been informed Al is not able to get the trailer needed to haul the equipment in the time frame required. We would like to use the original suggested vender and make arrangements to move forward. I will send a separate email with the details.
