

NSGSC Volunteer Head Coach Job Description



JOB DESCRIPTION

The NSGSC is one of the largest girls' clubs within BC and therefore requires a lot of volunteers. The role of Head Coach is important in setting the standards while emphasizing age appropriate skill development, fair play, teamwork, sportsmanship, and especially fun.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

- Create a friendly, welcoming, safe environment that encourages girls to improve and play soccer at all levels of play
- Teach players the game of soccer, good sportsmanship and fair play.
- Manage all aspects of practices: organize fun and challenging sessions for all players ensuring to consider the age appropriate development for the age being coached.
- Communication with team manager and players throughout the season
- Show up early to practices and games, organized with all necessary equipment
- Attend all relevant club meetings
- Do your best to create an environment that focuses on fun, development and retention.
- Parent Behaviour – guide sideline etiquette, and sure all field, club, referee, and game rules are followed in a respectful way.
- Host Pre-Season meeting setting standards and expectations, set season goals
- Ensure all coaches/managers/bench moms are registered with the club with current Criminal Record Checks
- Ensure to praise and encourage all players, use respectful/appropriate language
- Much of the process will be reinforced by a development culture that is supported by the volunteer coaches and technical staff.
- Hold a key role in the evaluation of players, ensuring to evaluate all players fairly, unbiased and in accordance with NSGSC Timelines

QUALIFICATIONS

- Head Coach must hold the specific BC SOCCER certification for the specific age group they are coaching
- Must have a valid Criminal Record Check (CRC) submitted to the NSGSC before working with the team
