

Apprentice Information

What is an apprentice?

An apprentice is an advanced skater that helps out during Learn to Skate classes on Monday and Thursday nights beginning at 6:30pm. Apprentices are supervised by the LTS coaches. The LTS Coaches will help direct the apprentices on what help they need. This is a really great way to take the skills you have learned and pass them on to others. Apprentices will be placed with groups that are age and level appropriate.

What incentives are there for being an apprentice?

Being an apprentice is getting to see all skaters improve in different skills and helping them on the way!! This is a great volunteer opportunity and many high school skaters use these hours and experience on scholarship applications and National Honor Society applications, etc.

Apprentices receive a gift certificate for each session that they are in attendance of 75% or more AND they will get the perk of having an additional number in the Spring Show- the Apprentice Number.

Apprentices **MUST** be in attendance 75% of both skating sessions to earn the incentives. This is noted in the show guidelines.

Expectations of an apprentice?

Apprentices are asked to wear black leggings and their black warm up jacket. They are expected to help with the classes, and should not be chatting with friends, or practicing their own skills. If an apprentice is unsure of what they should be doing, they should ask a LTS coach or the LTS Director, Tayler.

There are extra steps to become an apprentice this year. In addition to your US Figure Skating membership, each advanced skater that is going to apprentice will need their LTS USA membership. Getting your membership will include an \$18 fee that will be reimbursed! It will also include a certification course - this can be done at the apprentice meeting on Thursday, September 21st at 5:30 pm in the ALC lunchroom. Please bring a smartphone/device/ or tablet.

If you do not have a LTS membership and have not completed the LTS certification course, you will not be allowed on ice until these items are taken care of!
