



Kennedy Rink Guidelines

- Full team practices are allowed, with no limit on the number of participants, but a limit of 2 coaches per team.
- Games and competitions with other teams from the St. Louis Area Region are allowed.
- **NO** tournaments, performances or showcases are permitted, such as bracket style play where multiple teams play back to back.
- Players and officials **MUST** wear a face covering, including during, games, practices and while training if done indoors.
- Coaches **MUST** remain in mask/face coverings at all times.
- Players and coaches **MUST** sanitize hands and equipment regularly.
- Wearing masks before, during and immediately following activities is required, including prior to screening, except as specifically excluded during the individual athlete's or official's engagement in vigorous physical activity.
- Every individual participating in a practice or game, including coaches, must be screened every day that an individual participates in youth sports.
- No spectators unless you must be there for transportation/supervision. For games we will follow the leagues/host team's plan approved by DPH. If you have not done so yet, please send me your approved Department of Public Health plan.

Entering the Facility

- Entrance and exit doors are labeled.
- Allowed to enter no more than 15 minutes prior to reservation.
- Complete temperature check and contact tracing information.
- Come as dressed as possible. Locker rooms will not be available for getting dressed (outside of Mid-States High School Hockey games).
- There is two different staging areas to finish getting dressed and wait until Zamboni is on last lap.
- When Zamboni is on last lap, you can enter arena and set bags on bleachers, players benches or corner of the arena.
- Please do not get on the ice until Zamboni has exited and the doors have closed.

Exiting the Facility

- Collect your stuff and exit the arena promptly as the rental ends.
- Locker rooms are available for 10 minutes after ice rental ends.
- Locker rooms will not be assigned and is just an area to do a quick change (i.e. larger restroom). For Mid-States games, locker rooms will be assigned.
- No showers will be available.
