

Lakeview Shutdown Triggers

Listed are scenarios that would trigger a closure of Lakeview Arena. The length of any shutdown would be determined on a case by case basis.

Unable to properly staff the facility due to positive COVID cases or quarantines.

In the event that Lakeview can not be properly staffed, the facility will be shutdown until staff becomes available.

Marquette Area Public Schools shutdown

If there were to be a complete shutdown of MAPS in-person classes due to COVID, Lakeview will be shut down for the duration of the MAPS shutdown

COVID cases within the building without adequate contact tracing

In the event there is a positive case in the facility where the Health Department cannot adequately contact trace and Lakeview is listed as a possible exposure site the facility will shut down until proper sanitation and symptom monitoring is complete.

Known COVID transmissions within the building

In the event where positive COVID cases within the building cannot be easily isolated and cases begin to spread between teams, groups, spectators, and staff the facility will shut down for sanitation and symptom monitoring. This would not apply if the transmission is limited to a single team and that team can be isolated.

Continuous disregard for facility rules and policy

If Lakeview Arena COVID policies are disregarded and continue to be disregarded after being addressed, the facility will shut down to protect the community at large. Procedures are in place to allow the community to have this recreation opportunity while keeping the community safe.

Other Possibilities

Rather than a complete facility shutdown, Lakeview may determine the need to implement other policies/partial shutdowns due to COVID cases. Which could include:

- No travel or visitors – local games with Lakeview teams
- No games at all, just local teams practicing
