ICE SHOW POLICIES & PROCEDURES

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: THURSDAY, MAY 14, 2026

With very few rehearsal days allotted, ALL assigned group rehearsals and BOTH show performances are MANDATORY. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Please review the Rehearsal Schedule PRIOR TO committing to group registrations.

Please respect your fellow skaters and Ice Den families and DO NOT register to participate as part of a group number if you know in advance that you are unable to attend ALL required rehearsals and performances.

It disrupts training and choreography, and is unfair to the coaches, performers and spectators.

There will be NO REFUNDS issued on costumes, registrations or tickets. Due to ice show logistics and limited building space, the maximum number of performers per number is 24. Registration will be filled and assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.

COSTUMES

All costumes are ordered and coordinated by the Ice Den and are NOT custom made for anyone. We do our very best to ensure each skater looks fantastic! It is important that all skaters attend the scheduled fitting. All costumes will be distributed after costume fittings. It is the skater's responsibility to bring the costume/accessories to the dress rehearsal and performances. The skater will keep the costume clean and in good condition. We recommend trying the costume on with skates and all accessories ahead of the dress rehearsal. Please note, due to US Figure Skating guidelines ONLY SAFESPORT & BACKGROUND CHECKED volunteer chaperones will be permitted in the dressing rooms. Each group will have chaperones appointed to assist the skaters (see Volunteer Registration Form attached for more information).

PHOTOGRAPHY & VIDEO

A professional photographer is hired to photograph the shows. Personal cameras and video cameras are permitted but may **only** be used to film your own participant's performance, for personal use. *It is strictly prohibited to film any other skater's performance.* Only battery powered video units are allowed: electrical cords, tripods (or similar devices) are not permitted in the arena. For the safety of all skaters, no flash photography is permitted.

TICKETS WILL GO ON SALE: MAY 18, 2026.

- All shows are open seating - please do not save seats.
- All spectators/family members must present the appropriate ticket for entry into the arena. No exceptions.
- Children 5 and under are free for lap seating; to ensure a seat please purchase a ticket.
- Standing Room Only Ticket Sales: \$15.00 each. If a show sells out, Standing Room Only Tickets ("SRO") will be sold at Admin approximately 30 minutes prior to show time. SRO ticket holders will be admitted approximately 10 minutes prior to show time.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

As with all events of this size, we are recruiting volunteers to ensure the show runs smoothly. ONLY SAFESPORT & BACKGROUND CHECKED scheduled volunteers will have access to dressing rooms and backstage areas during the shows. Volunteers are not required to purchase tickets for the shows. If you are interested in volunteering, please complete the attached **Volunteer Registration Form**, and return it to the Administration Office.

PLEASE NOTE:

By volunteering, you are committing to work BOTH performances. **All volunteers MUST be available and at his/her assigned position 30 minutes prior to EACH show.** We thank you in advance as this ensures that the cast and audience can be admitted punctually.

Volunteer Forms are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis and must be included with the Skater Registration Form. A current email address and cell phone number are mandatory and required for communication. If you wish to be a volunteer, we recommend the registration form be submitted as soon as possible. All volunteers will be notified prior to the start of rehearsals for your assigned duty. A member of the skating department will notify you if all volunteer spots are filled.

Recognizing the short turn-around between shows, all volunteers and their skater(s) will be given a meal in between shows.

All programs must be paid in full at time of registration. Ice Den Scottsdale reserves the right to reschedule, change, or cancel a program due to circumstances beyond our control. Ice Den Scottsdale reserves the right to revoke participant privileges and future registration in any program offered at this facility. Agreement to Use Facilities of the Ice Den Scottsdale:

IMPORTANT: THIS IS A LEGAL DOCUMENT; PLEASE READ IN FULL AND UNDERSTAND BEFORE SIGNING.

In consideration of being permitted to participate in skating, hockey and other ice related activities at the Ice Den Scottsdale, I hereby agree to the following:

Assumption of Risk:

I understand and appreciate that: there are risks of serious personal injury in connection with participating in skating, ice hockey and other ice related activities and voluntarily assume and accept those risks, including the risk of illness from exposure to COVID-19 and other viruses. I unconditionally release, waive and covenant not to sue Coyotes Ice, LLC ("Ice Den Scottsdale") and any of their affiliates and subsidiaries, their promotional sponsors and advertisers, and their agents, servants and employees from any and all suits, claims and demands of any kind for personal injuries, property damage, including but not limited to lost, stolen or damaged goods, that I may sustain while participating in hockey, skating and all related activities at the Ice Den Scottsdale.

Consent to Treat:

I certify that, as participant, or as parent/guardian of said participant, I give my consent to Ice Den Scottsdale and staff to obtain medical care from any licensed physician, hospital, or clinic for myself/said participant, for any injury that could arise from participation in any activities at Ice Den Scottsdale.

Consent to Use of Image:

I hereby give my consent to Coyotes Ice, LLC and Coyotes Ice 2, LLC to use my image/likeness (or in the case of a child - my child's image/likeness) for the purpose of inclusion in any publications or videos related to Ice Den Scottsdale or Ice Den Chandler.

***REFUND POLICY: A refund will be approved only in the event of injury that is accompanied by written confirmation of a doctor that verifies a medical condition excusing the skater from participation in the program. This must be submitted within 10 days of injury. Refunds will not be awarded due to illness including but not limited to COVID-19 related illness, exposure, or level of comfort.**

No refunds will be given to a registrant who leaves because of their own desire or fails to attend.

DRESS SIZE CHART

How To Pick Your Sizes



To measure girth, place tape measure on center of right shoulder, run through crotch and back to right shoulder loosely (as shown in diagram).

NOTE: the girth is the most important measurement.

If in doubt, let the girth measurement determine size selection.

This is a guide to help determine correct sizing.

When between sizes it is strongly recommended to buy the larger size.
