



## **Baseball PEI Board of Directors' Meeting Minutes**

**Tuesday, 2 February 2021, 5:45 pm**

### **Meeting**

- 1) Walter called the meeting to order at 5:45 pm.
- 2) The Agenda for the meeting was reviewed.
  - o Motion to approve the agenda moved by Janet Cameron; seconded by Ian Clays. **Motion Passed.**
- 3) The Minutes from the last Board of Directors' Meeting (28 October 2020) was briefly reviewed.
  - o Motion to approve the Minutes of the 28 October 2020 meeting moved by Connor Myers; seconded by John Munro. **Motion Passed.**
- 4) Two motions that were voted upon electronically were formally passed.
  - o Motion to approve the spending of up to a maximum of \$250 per minor baseball association to subsidize up to half on either one or more pitching machines for 2021 moved by John Munro; seconded by Ian Clays. **Motion Passed.**
  - o Motion to approve the presented revised NCCP certification requirements for coaches at Baseball PEI Eliminations/Provincial Championships moved by John Munro; seconded by Ian Clays. **Motion Passed.**
- 5) Walter MacEwen gave a brief update on the current finances. Baseball PEI is in a very healthy financial situation, with more money to come in and only a few expenses to go out. There will be several projects and programs in 2021 that will require funds to be spent to improve baseball development.
  - o Motion to approve the acceptance of the financial report moved by Janet Cameron; seconded by Joelyne Taylor. **Motion Passed.**
- 6) Some Directors gave a short review and update of their area.
  - a. Janet Cameron updated the Board of Directors on the search for a coach of the 2021 Provincial 22U All-Stars. Two coaches have already been approached and have graciously declined. Another coach has been approached and we are still waiting to hear back from him. If anybody else has suggestions, they are asked to forward those suggestions to either Janet or Randy.
  - b. Connor Myers gave an update on the 2020/2021 Winter Camps. The two hitting, infielding and catching camps have been completed, with only positive things said by all those participating. The hitting camps were full, the infielding camp had approximately ten players take part, and the catching camp had approximately sixteen participants. The 11U and 12+ pitching camps have just started, and both are full. Tyler Johnston is leading these pitching camps, with Ben MacDougall, Dawson McCormack and Adam Connolly assisting.
  - c. Joelyne Taylor gave a few updates to the group about girls' baseball. Baseball PEI has received grants from the Province to cover the cost for all women/girls who take NCCP and PEIBUA clinics in 2021. The Girls'



Grassroots Baseball Committee (GGBC), with Jody Kinney, Erinn MacDougall and Joelyne met last week, and from their meeting, a Growth Plan for girls' baseball has been developed (and will be distributed to the Board of Directors as soon as possible). In this plan, it spoke to having girls' jamborees at Rally Cap and 11U in 2021 and building towards the all-girls leagues in 2022, more camps and clinics with a more "girl-friendly" mindset, any financial impediments in the way of girls' registering baseball should be minimized/removed, and more women/girls in role model positions (i.e. coaching and umpiring). On the point of reducing financial impediments, if all minor baseball associations agreed to charge all girls players no more than \$50 in 2021 and 2022, Baseball PEI will charge those associations \$10 (instead of \$35) per female player.

It was also mentioned that Kelly Wedge and Selena Ford have agreed to join the GGBC.

- d. Randy Byrne, along with Walter and John Munro, discussed the current work on creating a proposal to give to the PEIBUA in regards to a 2021 U.M.P. (Umpire Mentoring Program). A lot of work has gone into this project and three proposals have been formed. Kent Walker stopped by the Baseball PEI office and looked over the work done on this, and offered to examine it more and give feedback. Once that feedback is received, the proposals will be edited and a final proposal will be sent to the PEIBUA, and hopefully, Baseball PEI and the PEIBUA can create a valuable U.M.P. in 2021.
- e. Randy Byrne discussed a few topics.
  - i. Randy spoke to the upcoming clinics, including two Girls' clinics on a P.D. Day in late February (in Stratford and Summerside), a Girls' afternoon clinic on Easter Monday in Stratford, and a "Spring Training" Day in mid-April open for everybody (which will be run by Atlantic Baseball Academy employees as coaches/clinicians).
  - ii. Randy has contacted all of the schools on PEI to give them an update on baseball programs that can be done within their school and resources available. As such, he's now going to Georgetown on two half-days next week.
  - iii. Randy updated the Board of Directors on work done on "Play Catch" week, which will be done in conjunction with Baseball Canada and Rawlings, and Walter mentioned that Louie Murphy would love to take part.
  - iv. As far as a PEI-version of "Hit, Run and Throw," Randy got information from Lorne Carmichael – through Walter – and will work to design a program over the next month.
  - v. Randy gave the group some insight into the work that the Atlantic Canadian E.D.s have been doing to create events for Provincial teams if National Championships are cancelled in 2021.
  - vi. Finally, Randy presented the current copies of a form for low-income players wanting their registration reimbursed and the plan for the "A" league coaches meeting/camps and asked that people review them and send in thoughts/observations/suggestions.
- 7) The role of Rally Cap in initiation baseball was discussed. In the grassroots report created last month, the need to reinvigorate Rally Cap was a major theme. As a result, it was determined that Baseball PEI need to hire somebody to lead Rally Cap (in a similar way we pay Desi Doyle to administer NCCP). This person would be trained in the proper implementation of Rally Cap – both in-person and through the NCCP Rally Cap program – and how to run testing sessions. This person would lead clinics in Rally Cap sessions across the Island, look to train coaches on the proper implementation of Rally Cap within minor baseball associations, help with testing, work with associations to set up Jamborees, and head the Provincial Rally Cap Jamboree Day. The Board of Directors agreed that an honorarium of \$3000 should be put towards this position, and there should be an open hiring process for this position.



- Motion to set up an open, advertised hiring competition for the position of “Rally Cap Coordinator” within Baseball PEI, with a yearly honorarium of \$3000, moved by Janet Cameron; seconded by John Munro.

**Motion Passed.**

- 8) A date for the 2021 Presidents’ Meeting was discussed. It was decided that Saturday, 27 February at 9 am would be the preferred date for the Presidents’ Meeting (if weather is inclement, the meeting will be done via Zoom).

Topics to be discussed include:

- a. Girls’ baseball growth plan.
  - b. Grassroots report and a renewed emphasis on Rally Cap, potential changes to 9U, et cetera.
  - c. A reminder of the program for registration assistance for low-income players.
  - d. The need for associations to work more with “A” level coaches to ensure they are prepared.
  - e. The need for more work to be done to recruit umpires, especially in rural associations.
  - f. A reminder of revised Associations in Good-Standing Policy.
  - g. Current plans for 2021 Guidelines related to Covid-19.
- 9) The suggested changes to the Discipline Guidelines Policy were discussed. At the Fall Forum, several people suggested a minimum one-game suspension for any ejection. While some agreed with that, others on the Board of Directors were wary of this, as some ejections aren’t worthy of a suspension and there could be a lot of issues raised by this black-and-white approach. After some back-and-forth, it was agreed that Randy would go back to the Discipline Guidelines Policy and on any ejection involving a coach, there will be a minimum of a one-game suspension, but on player ejections, depending on the offence, there won’t be a suspension. At the end of the day, coaches have to be more responsible for their actions. After drafting those changes, Randy will distribute to the Board of Directors for feedback.
- 10) Randy presented a proposed 2021 Baseball PEI Calendar. It is basically the same format as the 2020 Calendar before Covid-19 wreaked havoc with its dates. It was agreed that this would be the Calendar going forward for 2021, and if changes need to be made due to Covid-19 or whatever else happens, those changes would be needed on a case-by-case basis.
- Motion to approve the proposed 2021 Baseball PEI Calendar moved by Ian Clays; seconded by Janet Cameron. **Motion Passed.**
- 11) The proposed 2021 Baseball PEI Procedures Manual was analyzed. Most changes were clarifications of unclear wordings and points in previous Procedure Manuals or issues discussed by the Board of Directors throughout the winter. The Board of Directors agreed with all changes made.
- 12) The proposed “A” Leagues Meetings/Camps was discussed a little more in-depth. The goal of this day is to have a comprehensive league meeting in all “A” leagues, have a quick classroom session, and then get on the field for an hour, breaking down the groups into stations giving quick drills coaches can use in practices, and do all of this in three hours or less. The question is what can be included and what should be excluded, knowing that the longer this event goes, the fewer coaches will participate. All Board members were asked to review the current plan, and send thoughts and suggestions to Randy by next Monday (8 February 2021).
- 13) New business:
- a. Walter MacEwen gave the group a brief recap of Alf Blanchard’s efforts to set up a PEI 22U League. It looks very promising that there will be a 22U League on PEI in 2021.
- 14) There was no in-camera session.
- 15) John Munro adjourned this meeting at 7:16 pm.

### Important Points in Regards to Baseball Canada NCCP

- All coaches on the bench/field must complete the Coaches Association of Canada (CAC) online Safe Sport Training, regardless of their participation in Baseball PEI Provincial Tournaments or not.
- Please note that for 22U baseball, the certification listed is for coaches attending Baseball Canada National Championships. As far as any 22U baseball taking place on Prince Edward Island, it will be that league’s prerogative as to what NCCP certification is necessary for coaches.
- Please note for 11U “A” and 9U baseball, the NCCP certification listed above is recommended by Baseball PEI but is not mandatory.
- To be able to complete any online modules, a coach must have a National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP) number and a Baseball Canada NCCP profile.
  - If a coach doesn’t have an NCCP number, he/she shall create a Baseball Canada NCCP profile at <https://nccp.baseball.ca/>. Once the profile is complete, an NCCP number will be assigned to the coach.
  - If a coach does have an NCCP number but does not have a Baseball Canada NCCP profile, when creating the Baseball Canada NCCP profile, that number must be listed within the creation of the coach’s profile.
- The “Coach Initiation into Sport” and “Coach Initiation into Baseball (Fundamentals)” online modules must be completed to register for any in-person or online NCCP clinics.
  - Once those two online modules are completed, a coach can register for Baseball Canada NCCP clinics.
- The following online modules and tasks/portfolios are to be registered for and completed within a coach’s Baseball Canada NCCP profile on <https://nccp.baseball.ca/>:
  - Coaching Initiation into Sport
  - Coaching Initiation into Baseball (Fundamentals and/or Rally Cap)
  - My First Pitch eLearning
  - Core Portfolio Evaluation
    - The following clinics must be completed to register for the Core Portfolio Evaluation: Teaching & Learning, Absolutes, Planning, and Pitching & Catching.
  - Portfolio Tasks
    - 11U, 13U, 15U and 16+.
  - Video Packages
    - 11U, 13U, 15U and 16+.
  - The Practice and Game Evaluations shall be registered for within a coach’s Baseball Canada NCCP profile. The online Core Portfolio Evaluation must be completed and passed before registering for the in-person Practice and Game Evaluations.
- The following online modules are to be registered for and completed within a coach’s NCCP Locker page (which each coach can create with his/her NCCP number):
