MAYBA FEES

The fees for participating in MAYBA are as follows:

MAYBA In House Fee: \$250

Players will be placed on an “in house” team. Fee includes in house practice(s) during the week and in house game(s) at night during the week. Fee also includes uniform and hat.

**Evaluations will take place for summer traveling teams.

10U-12U Traveling Fee: \$200

There are evaluations for the traveling teams. This fee includes participation in 6 tournaments: 4 away tournaments, one home tournament, and a state or final tournament. You are not allowed to travel if you are not a part of the daily practices and in house MAYBA league. Fee includes weekly practices and travelling hat and jersey.

13U Traveling Fee: \$250

*More than 10U-12U due to spring games/tournaments.

There are evaluations for the traveling teams. This fee includes participation in 8 tournaments: 2 spring tournaments (1 home 1 away), 4 summer away tournaments, one home summer tournament, and a state or final tournament.

14U Traveling Fee: \$475

This fee includes participation in 8 tournaments: 2 spring tournaments (1 home 1 away), 4 summer away tournaments, one home summer tournament, and a state or final tournament. 14 Year olds will play in a southwest MN league on Mondays and Thursdays throughout June and July. These teams will also play spring games in April/May. Fee includes weekly practices and traveling hat and jersey.
