Financial summary/highlights

- Great deal on ice time
- Registration fees, buyouts, and overall revenues increased in 2023-2024
 - Fees unlikely to change next year
 - Dibs buyouts earned more revenue than last year, next year cost TBD
 - Tournament fees (13k) did not cover tournament expenses (20k); hosting state was huge, as was the Mite Jamboree
- Big donation year
 - Jim Swanson Memorial
 - Scholarships
- Wreath profit margin improved from 34.7% to 36.4%; KT car wash cards margin of 41.4%
 - Total fundraising lower this year; UTV raffle was big winner last year
- Concessions profit lower than 2022-2023; less Stout games, inflation

Membership Growth/Registration Trends:



- Opportunity: We need to continue to built our LTS/Mite Program, need for increased “growth” & “marketing,” leverage girls growth.
- Leverage hockey excitement!! Looking for ideas!!

Utilization & Maximization of WAP Hours

- Un-Staffed Concession Stand, Open Skate & Beer Sales
 - 2 Open Skates Closed & unstaffed concession hours
 - We did improve over last year. 65 unclaimed hours vs. 128.
 - Rink Cleaning Need- No Home Tournaments
- Multiple Committee Positions Unfilled
- **Opportunity: WE STILL NEED MORE MEMBER HELP!!**
 - We are not meeting the needs of our program via the current DIBs requirements
 - **DIB requirements and concession hours may change next year. Possibly less regular Dibs required and more Concession hours.**



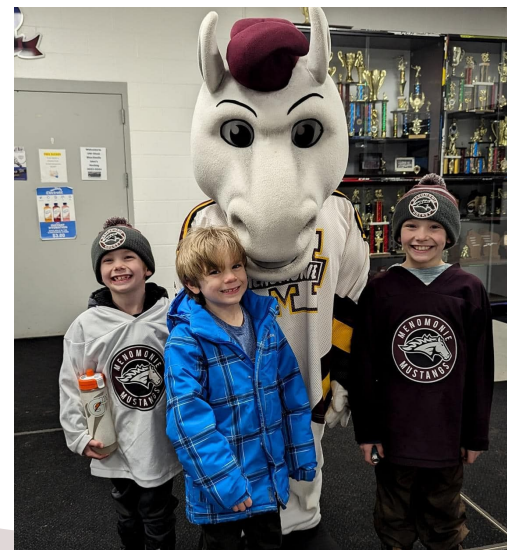

- ❑ Girls have the opportunity to play with the co-op or remain with MYHA U10-14

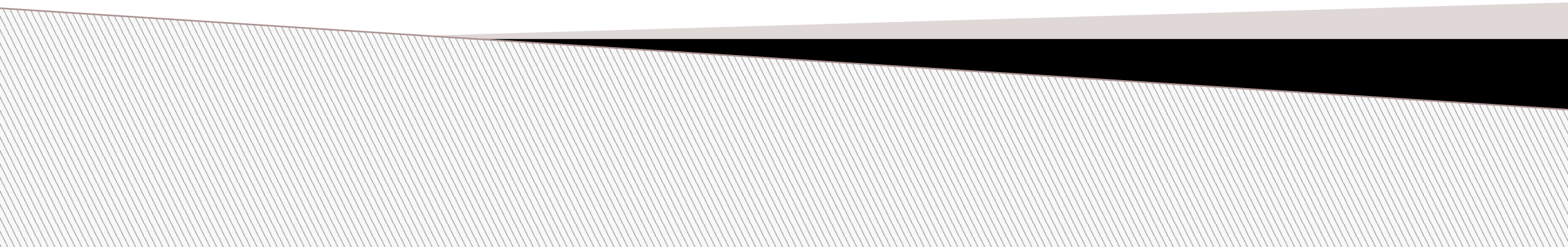
