**Re: Fine system for locker room supervision**

#### **Locker Room Supervision/Monitoring**

**For every USA Hockey sanctioned team: properly screened and SafeSport compliant coaches, team managers and/or Association administrators shall be responsible for compliance with the locker room supervision requirements set forth in the USA Hockey SafeSport Policy/Handbook. Failure by a coach or administrator to take appropriate steps to ensure adherence to the Locker Room Policy, or violation thereof by any participant or parent of a participant is subject to appropriate disciplinary action. It should also be noted that a local program may at its discretion adopt stricter policies than those defined by USA Hockey or ASHA, but in no case may said policy be less strict. Associations found in violations of this policy may be sanctioned in the following manner:**

**>1st offense: \$200.00 fine to the team and one game suspension to the head coach.**

**>2nd offense: \$400.00 to the team and two game suspension to the head coach.**

**>3rd offense: the head coach and an Association representative shall attend a ASHA disciplinary hearing which may result in further sanctions up to and including fines, suspensions and/or post season sanctions.**

**\* This would be added into current SafeSport wording in the ASHA manual in the area of SafeSport locker room policies.**

**\*Also, it is my intention that violations may only occur in two ways as to eliminate "tattle tales"**

**> Offenses can be generated by SafeSport events/incidents which are investigated and it becomes apparent the incident in question was partially or fully caused by lack of locker room supervision.**

**> or persons named by the ASHA President....such as State and Associate SafeSport Coordinators, tournament directors, and any other persons so empowered by the ASHA President who may from time to time "spot check" for compliance to locker room policies.**
