a. State Championship Results

- i. Trap: Team 4th in Class and 16th Overall. We had 8-25's and 1-50 by Alex Taylor.
- ii. Skeet: 3rd Place in State! 1-25 by Mason Meyer, 1-50 by Gabe Anderson.
- iii. 5-Stand: Team 4th Overall. Individual awards to Mason Meyer, Makena Fredrickson, Keegan O'Keeffe and Cole Thompson.

b. State MSHSL Results

- i. Team: 35th Overall. Mason had a 25 and Alex Taylor had a 50!
- ii. Individual: Mason Meyer finished with a 96, 36 overall!
- iii. State Team players were chosen by coaches.

- 1. Wayzata won team event – 3 straight 100's

c. Nationals

- i. Five athletes shooting as a team and individually July 8-9. If the team or any individual qualify, finals are on July 10.
- ii. Club would like to take more shooters to Nationals.
- iii. Register 1 team at lowest individual – and able to register a 2nd team until they get to Tier 3.
