State Report:

Karen stated she attended the state meeting on December 23rd. The focus was how to successfully get back on the ice following all the state guidelines. A few changes that have been made: We can no longer allow spectators to stay during practices. There can be no more than 25 players/coaches on the ice at one time. Practices have to be no contact, players have to stay 6 ft apart. No scrimmages or games at this time. Everyone was asked to review the "Return To Play Guidelines for 2020-2021" with the new 9.1 updates.

Proposed Practice Schedule:

Karen stated she has put a practice schedule together based on what is available for ice. With having to split the teams and everyone having a full sheet of ice she is going to schedule a practice on what would have been the teams home game ice.

Judy asked what the total of ice would be? Judy stated that based on what we have for funds we could rent up to 180 hrs from now until March. Karen stated that we would be under 80 hrs a month if the schedule stay as is.

Adam stated that practices will not look the same. He has a few ideas on how to keep the kids moving but also keeping them spread out. He would like to utilize the cones for the players to stand by. Adam will schedule a coaches meeting for Wednesday, December 30th at 6:30pm.

Karen suggested there be no water bottles on the benches especially for the younger players who need help with their helmets and masks.

A message will be sent to all the families notifying them of all the changes.
