**SCORERS & TIMERS INSTRUCTIONS**

**OFFICIAL SCORER** shall be seated at the officials' table and is responsible for: (a) recording points scored by each contestant when signalled by the referee; (b) recording the wrestler who makes the choice at the start of the second and third periods and the position of the at the start of the second and third periods; (c) constantly checking with the visiting team's scorer; (d) immediately advising the match timekeeper when there is any disagreement regarding the score; (e) advising the scoreboard operator or assistant scorers of the correct score during each match; (f) recording the completion time of matches; and (g) presenting the referee with the scorebook at the end of each match.

**ASSISTANT SCORERS** are responsible for recording points earned by each individual wrestler during the course of the match. As points are earned in a dual meet, a running team score shall be kept following each individual match.

**MATCH TIMEKEEPER** is responsible for: (a) keeping the overall time of the match; (b) recording the accumulated timeouts for injury; (c) recovery time; (d) notifying the referee of any significant situation when the match is stopped, or for disagreement by official scorer and timekeeper, or when requested by a coach to discuss a possible error; (e) assisting, when requested by the referee, in determining whether a situation occurred before or after the termination of a period; and (f) when a visual clock is not available, calling the minutes to referee, contestants and spectators and displaying with visual cards the number of seconds remaining in the last minute of the period at 15 second intervals.

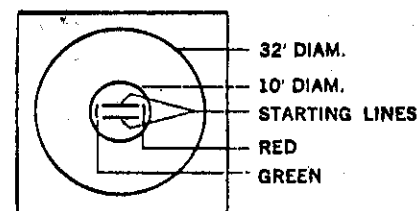
**THERE ARE SEVERAL WAYS TO EARN POINTS DURING A MATCH.**

- TAKEDOWN = 2 PTS.** Opponent is brought to the mat and controlled from a neutral or standing position
- ESCAPE = 1 PT.** Wrestler breaks away from the opponent's control into a neutral or standing position.
- REVERSAL = 2 PTS.** Wrestler reverses his opponent and gains control in one continuous maneuver.
- NEAR FALL = 3 PTS.** Wrestler almost gets a pin; his opponent's shoulders are momentarily held within 4" or less of the mat; or one shoulder is touching the mat and the other is held at an angle of 45° or less to the mat. Two points. Or, if either situation occurs continuously for 5 seconds. Three points.

There are three common infractions which cost a wrestler a loss of points:

- STALLING = 1 PT.** This is a matter of not trying for a takedown or escape or simply not wrestling aggressively. After a warning, continued stalling gives the opponent one point.
- ILLEGAL HOLDS = 1 PT.** There are several specific holds that are dangerous or punishing to a wrestler. These are known to all competitors and anyone using them loses one point to his opponent.
- TECHNICAL VIOLATIONS** There are a number of situations or actions that can cost a wrestler one point: delaying a match; intentionally going off the mat; clasping hands around the opponent's body or legs while in a position of control.

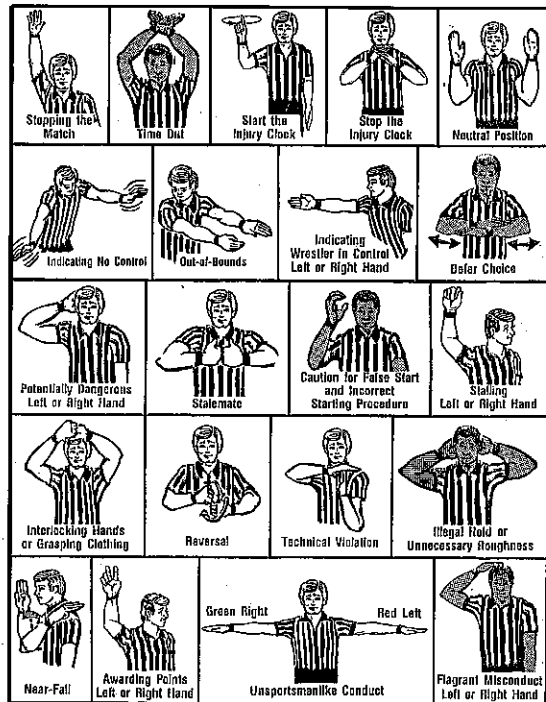

The wrestling area is composed of cushioned mats and can be either circular or square in shape. It must have additional mat protection around the edges.

A match is 6 minutes long, divided into 3 equal periods. Each wrestler is given either a green or red ankle band so he may be identified during the match. The first period is started in a neutral position; the wrestlers face each other in a standing position on opposite sides of the starting circle. At the beginning of the second period one wrestler (determined by a flip) will have four options: to be on his feet, top position, bottom position or to defer his choice until the 3rd period.

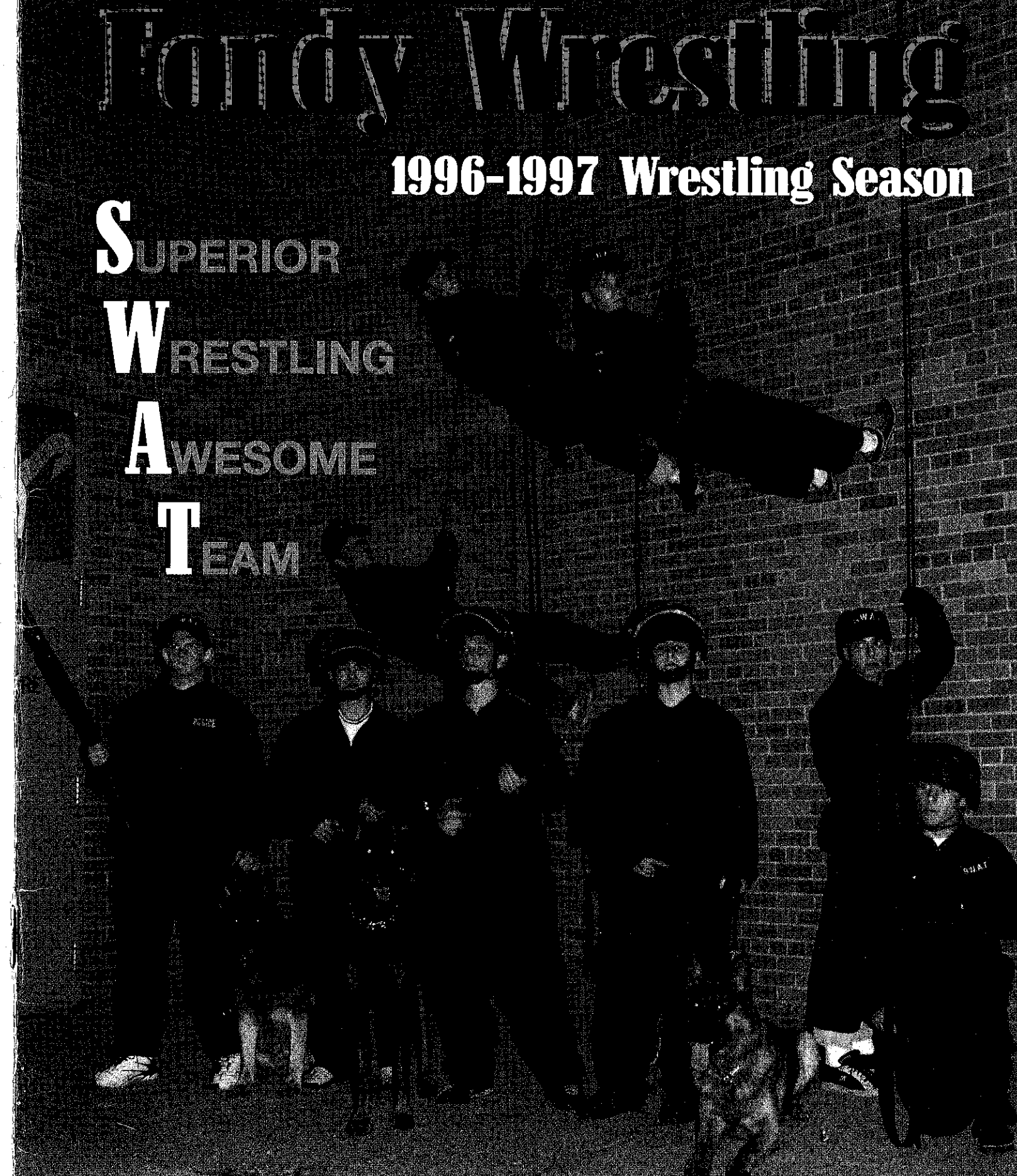

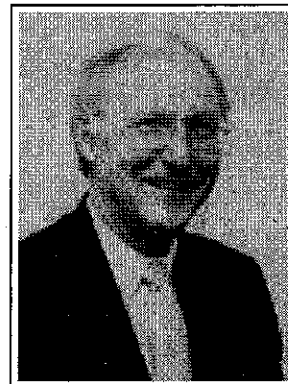

## Michael J. Homes, Ph.D., Superintendent

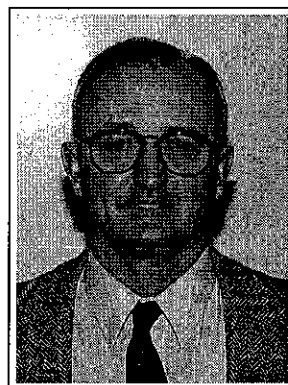

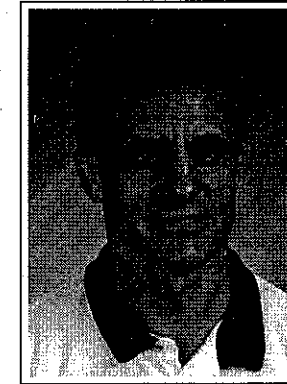
# Meet the Goodrich Coaches

## Larry Marchionda, Head Coach

Larry attended Penn Yan Academy in Penn Yan, New York, where he accumulated a 97-4 high school record. His senior year in high school Larry was unbeaten and pinned every opponent. He attended Winona State University where he earned his Bachelor and Master of Science Degree. He was a 1968 Olympic Regional Champion and a finalist in the 1968 Olympic Trials at Ames, Iowa. He has won several Wisconsin State AAU and USA Freestyle and Greco Roman Championships.

Larry is beginning his 30th year as a head wrestling coach 28th for the Cardinals. He has compiled a dual meet record of 294-53. His team has won 84 tournaments, 14 Regionals, 8 Sectionals and one State Championship in 1991. His team has qualified for the WIAA State Team Tournament twice.

Larry was inducted into the WISCONSIN WRESTLING HALL OF FAME in 1983. He was named Conference Coach of the Year in 1980, 88, 90, 91, 92 and 93. Wisconsin Coach of the Year in 1988, 91, and 93. Larry was also named to WHO'S WHO AMONG UNITED STATE WRESTLING COACHES in 1988.



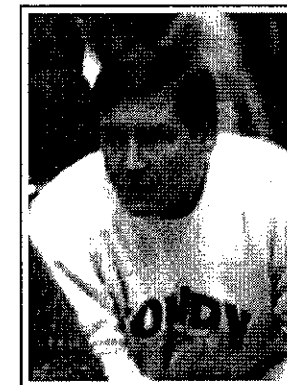
## Ed Brady, Assistant Coach

Presently, Ed teaches math at Sabish and Goodrich. He also coaches football and track.

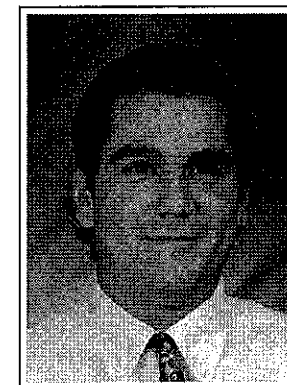

# Fox Valley Association Conference



## Fox Valley Association Code of Sportsmanship

The Fox Valley Association believes that sportsmanship is important for participants and spectators alike. The member schools of the Fox Valley Association therefore pledge themselves to encourage positive displays of sportsmanship at all co-curricular activities. The following principles have been adopted to reflect this strong belief:

1. Interscholastic competition exists for its educational value. Although winning is important, the prime objective is to appreciate the educational and athletic development of our young people.
2. Spectators and participants are all guests at this educational experience and have a responsibility to uphold the ideals of good manners and sportsmanship.
3. We recognize that game officials do their best to make quick, fair, and unbiased decisions and should be treated with respect and authority.
4. Every competitor is worthy of our respect and should be treated with courtesy.
5. A true competitor is humble in victory and steadfast in defeat.

## GUIDELINES

1. All Fox Valley Association schools are tobacco free schools. Smoking is not permitted in the school building, on school grounds or on the premises during any activity.
2. Consumption of alcohol/drugs prior to entering a contest or possession/consumption of alcohol/drugs during a contest is prohibited.
3. The use of noise makers, projectiles (including balls) and confetti is prohibited.
4. Harassment of officials or members of participating schools is prohibited.
5. Only authorized cheerleaders will be permitted on the floor/field to lead the cheers.
6. All participants and spectators should refrain from the use of inappropriate language.
7. All cheers should be meant to be in support of your team, they should not be used to ridicule or antagonize the other team.
8. Participants and spectators should respect school property, kicking, or stomping of bleachers is prohibited.

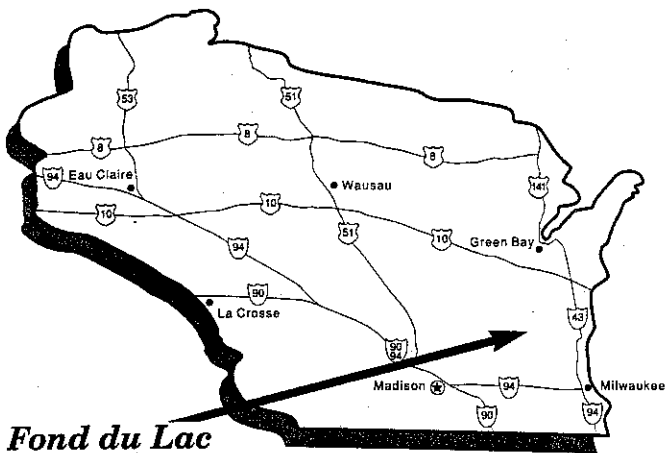

# Stangel twins go out in style in Fondy loss

Hartford takes final 3 matches for narrow win

WEST ALLIS — Goodrich High School wrestlers Dave and Kirk Stangel have shared virtually every moment of their lives.

Just as they entered life together, the identical senior twins ended their prep careers the same way as well.

In a sport where the heat of battle in practice can sometimes turn the closest friends into temporary adversaries, the Stangels have found a happy medium. They admit to a degree of sibling rivalry, but they try to keep it in the practice room. "We've always competed with

each other, but it's good having him there," said Fox Valley Association champion Kirk. "We're partners. We live together, so if we get frustrated we can't stay that way because we're always (with each other)."

"It's kind of an advantage having him," said Dave, a third-place FVA placemaker. "He's a good practice partner. We go pretty hard."

The Stangels are the first twins to compete simultaneously in Larry Marchionda's 28 seasons as coach at Goodrich. He believes their success is directly related to each other.

"They really help each other out," he observed. "They push each other to work hard."

The brothers' competitive spirit hasn't made them enemies. "We hang out a lot together," said Kirk. "His friends are my friends. With him, I always have somebody to do something with."

On Friday, the victories by the Stangels capped a four-match winning streak by the Cardinals that began with decision victories by freshman Brad Caserta and senior Brandon McNab.

The streak gave Fond du Lac a 23-16 lead over Hartford, but the Orioles came back to win the final

three matches, including a narrow 4-3 win by Wisconsin Little Ten Conference champion Justin Kienast over Gabe Munoz in the 275-pound final.

Although Munoz stands 5-foot-9 and weighs 220 pounds, he was dwarfed by some 10 inches by the larger Kienast.

"Gabe was giving away almost 50 pounds," Marchionda observed. "That's a lot to give away, but he wrestled a good match."

Sophomore Travis Seaton got the Cardinals off to a fast start by pinning Tom Buvyske in just 1:03 in the 103-pound opener. Fond du Lac also got a major decision from senior Kahuho Yanagawa.

"The kids wrestled well," Marchionda said. "The kids that had real tough matches did a great job."

Fond du Lac finished at 12-3, wrestled, Marchionda repeated. "Yeah, we lost. But we wrestled good."
