A sign with the QR Code is supposed to be available to scan at the ballpark each day if you do not purchase in advance.

Players/Coaches/Athletic Trainer - Free.

5 and under are free .

Teams get up to 10 free tickets each for coaches family members, plus 1 free ticket for scorekeeper.

You will need to provide NCHEAC a list of names each day of those that get in free.

Woodpeckers will be checking names upon entry. **ID required.** NCHEAC will give the list to

Woodpeckers. Please turn in the list for each day by Wednesday (April 15) noon. If any updates are needed after then, send those updates to NCHEAC. Email: sports@nche.com.

NOTE: For first game each day, no fans are allowed in until 9:00 a.m. Players and coaches will be allowed in at 8:00 a.m. Have parents drop off players, but the parents cannot enter until 9:00 as to give time for staff to get things ready.

PARKING:

Parking is ran by the city and is 5.00 max per day. Saturday is free parking.

There is a deck at the stadium. **No cash.**

CONCESSIONS:

Woodpeckers will be selling normal ballpark concessions. **NO CASH. CARD ONLY.**

No outside food and coolers are allowed to be brought in by fans (exception would be water only).

Team coolers will be allowed.

BASEBALLS:

EACH TEAM IS TO BRING A DOZEN NEW BASEBALLS.

Diamond DOL1 HS NOCSAE - NFHS Stamped **or** Wilson A1010HS1 HS NOCSAE - NFHS Stamped.

(Turn in to Dale on Thursday).

TRAINER:

Each team is responsible for their first aid kit and medical professional / trainer.

Looks like it will be on the warm side. Please make sure kids are hydrated.

SPORTSMANSHIP/CONDUCT:

Please be respectful to the umpires and the other teams.

Let fans know as well. If anyone is asked to leave due to bad behavior it will be up to each program's coach or leadership person to make sure the matter gets taken care of.

GAME RELATED INFORMATION:

A. A pitcher gets 120 pitches total in the tournament – no rest day required.

Pitch count applies only to pitches during an at bat.

After your game please turn in you pitch counts. Options: export the box score as a PDF from Gamechanger or take a screen shot or just text the counts to the NCHEAC staff person on site that day. We will have a group text setup. Or email to sports@nche.com.

B. Mercy Rule - 15 runs ahead after 3 innings;

10 after 4 innings;

8 after 5 innings. (Games 1-10).

Go back to regular 10 runs ahead after 5 innings (Games 11-13).

C. Higher Seed will be HOME team for Thursday's games (1-5).

Friday's games (6-9) will be determined by coin toss.

Saturday's games (10-11 and 13) will be determined by coin toss.

Remaining undefeated team will be home team in game 12.

HOME dugout is first base side.

Note. On Saturday, we won't switch dugouts. The next team up in game 11 will take the open dugout of the team eliminated. Same procedure for remaining games.

D. Coaches – when doing the lineup – please make an extra copy for the public address announcer (if we have anyone to do it). NOTE. South Wake has someone to do their games and can do for both teams. For championship on Saturday, if we have no one, a Woodpeckers staff member may do it that game.

- E. Fields are to be prepped in between games, so no pregame warmups on infield. Can do warmup in the outfield.
- F. Batting Cage Times (2 section cage) Located in the Right Field area.
Home Team - (1) Hour (50) Minutes Before Game Time
Away Team - (1) Hour (10) Minutes Before Game Time
- G. Prayer and National anthem to be played at the start of each day. National anthem again for championship game.
- H. 2 umpires used on Thursday and Friday. 3 umpires for Saturday.
- I. Please have teams ready to play 20 minutes before scheduled time.
- J. Note: We will need to be out of the stadium by 11 pm on Thursday. To make sure we can get the 5 games completed we will be placing a 2:15 cap on all games that day. No inning will be started after 2:15 for Thursday games.
- K. There are a few worn grass spots in the foul territory that we may need to be aware of that got worn some during the past 9 game homestand the Woodpeckers had. Coaches are to be aware of those spots and avoid when warming up, etc.
- L. Please have someone from your program to retrieve foul balls and turn them in at the HOME team dugout.
- M. See below for "if needed" related to other game information.

Note: On Thursday I think there is another event in the facility area (Military Club).
On Saturday, if we have the 13th game – there is a Prom event scheduled at the facility area.
These are just FYI. Shouldn't affect us but just a heads up.

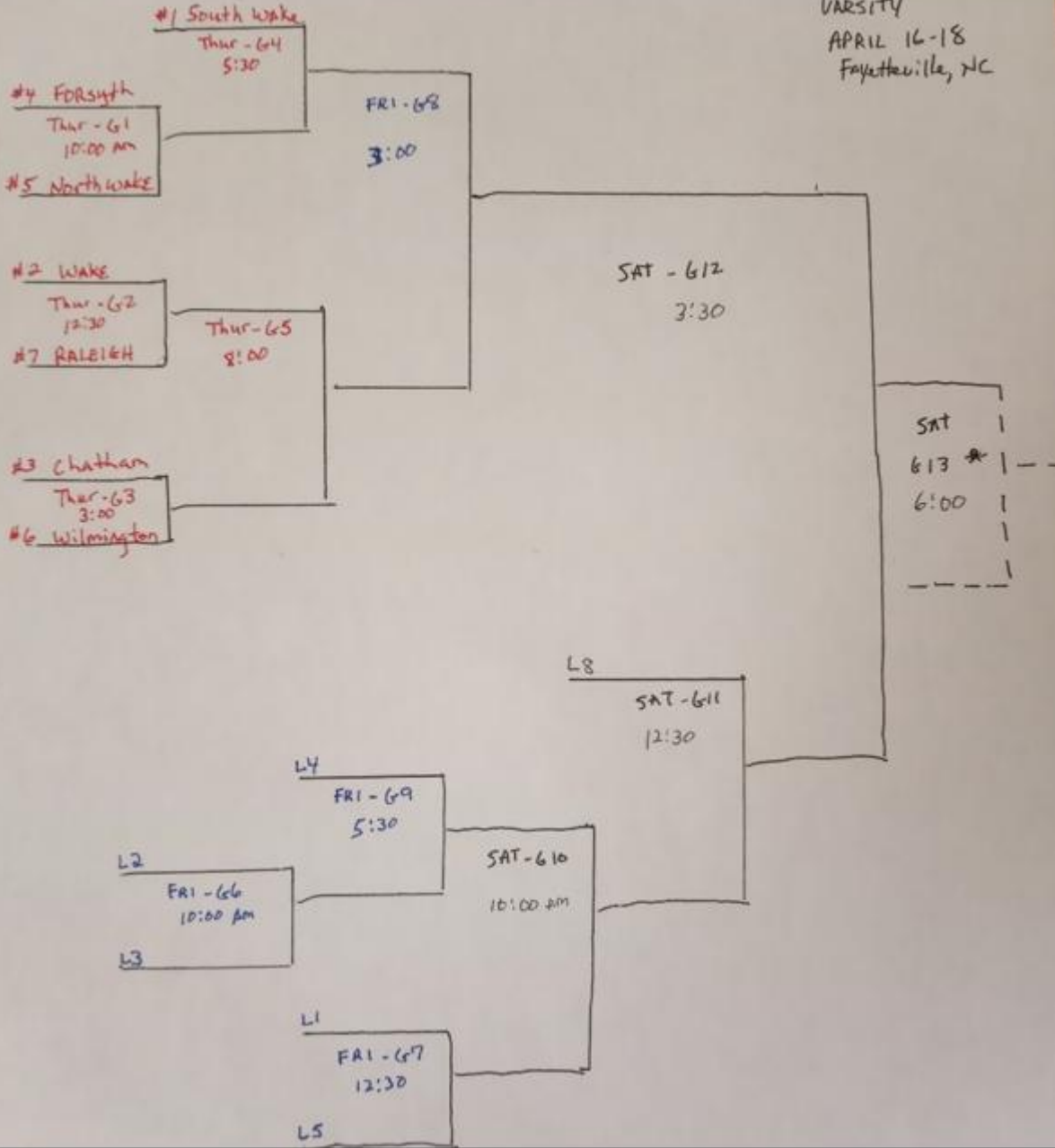
Higher Seed will be HOME team for Thursday's games (1-5).

Suspended Games - North Carolina has adopted the suspended game rule, mandatory in all regular season and state playoff games. A game called for any reason, where a winner cannot be determined will be treated as a suspended game.

(1) If the game is to be completed it will be continued from the point of interruption, with the lineup and batting order of each team the same as the lineup and batting order at the point of interruption, subject to the rules of the game.

(2) If more than 4 ½ innings have been played and a winner can be determined, the game is over (including playoff games).

(3) After 5 innings, if the visiting team scores a tying or go ahead run in their top half of the inning and the home team does not have an opportunity to bat or complete its time at bat, the game is treated as a suspended game.

(4) If a game is called prior to the completion of a full inning after the fifth inning, the game becomes a suspended game in the following situation: the visiting team has scored one or more runs to tie the score or take the lead, and the home team has not tied the score or retaken the lead.

Ex. - The sixth inning begins with score H-6, V-5. Visitors score two runs in their half of the inning. Game is called because of rain with :

(a) two outs in the bottom of the sixth and the score H-6, V-7; = the game is suspended and resumed on the next possible date at the point of interruption.

(b) following the completion of the home team's turn at bat with the score H-6, V-7; = the game is official, with the final score H-6, V-7.
